2015 APS CCRPI Data Report

The Georgia Department of Education released 2015 CCRPI results on May 22. The district overall score rose from 62.6 to 67.0. While the district overall score increased, scores are not directly comparable to last year, due to both the change from CRCT to Milestones (which lowered scores), and changes in the calculations, most notably the benchmarking of progress scores (which raised scores). State scores have not yet been released, so we do not know if the state also had an increase in average score.

After recalculating the CCRPI scores for current and planned mergers, 19 schools have three years in a row of CCRPI scores below 60. Seven schools that previously had three years below 60 scored above 60 this year: Benteen, Dobbs, Toomer, Usher, Sylvan, Mays, and Therrell Law.

After 2014, 27 schools had three years in a row below 60 on CCRPI. Of those 27, 1 closed (Intown), seven scored above 60, two merged (or are about to merge) with higher-performing schools (Washington HSN and Carver Tech), and 17 remain on the list. Two additional schools, Miles and Fain, have joined those 17.

Analysis shows that 2015 CCRPI scores are similarly correlated with 2014, 2013, and 2012 results, as opposed to being most strongly correlated to 2014. This tells us that single-year changes in CCRPI scores are *usually* temporary fluctuations, as opposed to representative of long term trends. Because of this, the tables below are sorted by three-year averages. This document is composed of three parts:

Section 1: CCRPI scores for the past three years, pages 2-6. These tables report scores as reported from GADOE; scores are not combined to show effects of current and planned mergers. For schools that cross grade levels, both the grade-level score and the single score (which combines grade levels) are reported in separate tables. Other APS briefs will only contain the single score, which is used for accountability.

Section 2: CCRPI progress percentages for the past three years, pages 7-10. These tables report scores as reported from GADOE; scores are not combined to show the effects of current and planned mergers.

Section 3: Information on schools eligible for the Opportunity School District, pages 11-12. Scores are combined to show the effects of current and planned mergers.

Section 2: Tables of CCRPI progress percentages for the past three years

Elementary school progress points measure growth in 4th and 5th grade, which is only one third of an elementary school. It is helpful to view this data in combination with the district's <u>Milestones vs.</u> <u>Challenge graphs</u>, which better reflect the effects of K-3 instruction.
