As the parent(s) or guardian(s) of a Grady High School student, you are receiving this letter to provide an update on the changes with regard to your child's schedule. The high school master schedule has been adjusted and classes created and/or dissolved as necessary to level classes to state mandated class sizes. It is important to note that all schedule changes will be permanent through the end of the school year in May 2015, barring any significant increases or decreases in enrollment. Counselors/Academy Leaders will not be able to return students back to their former schedule and/or teacher(s).

Be assured that any change to a student's schedule is in complete accordance with state of Georgia requirements. Additionally, there will be no loss of grades. All grades will follow students according to any adjustment(s) in their schedule.
