What is the model for traditional Summer Academy?

Summer Academy is designed to provide students with the opportunity to recover credits in a high school site. Students will receive instruction in a blended learning environment using Edgenuity while receiving teacher support.

Students enrolling in Summer Academy must take two classes.

What is the model for Atlanta Virtual Academy?

Atlanta Virtual Academy (AVA) allows students to take up to two classes during the summer session through online learning. Students must have access to a working computer with internet.

Students must log into their classes daily.

What are the expectations for students during Summer Academy?

Students are expected to maintain consistent attendance, positive behavior, and a commitment to learning during the Summer Academy. Students who have excessive absences, behave inappropriately or are not engaged in learning may be dismissed from the program.

What classes can students take?

Counselors will work with students to determine individual course requests for Summer Academy and/or Atlanta Virtual Academy.

Students may enroll in two courses in traditional Summer Academy and two courses in Atlanta Virtual Academy.

What are the school sites for the Summer Academy program?

What services are provided at Summer Academy?

Transportation is provided to each traditional high school Summer Academy site. Bus stops and routes will vary from the regular school year. Transportation is not provided to charter school students.

Breakfast and lunch **meal service** will be provided at each high school Summer Academy site.

Both the traditional Summer Academy program and Atlanta Virtual Academy are FREE for eligible students.
