WHO WE ARE LOOKING FOR

We look for high-performing, under-resourced students who have already demonstrated true leadership and positive community contributions.

To be eligible applicants must:

- :: Be a graduating high school senior planning to attend a four-year accredited academic institution
- :: Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident of the U.S. and a legal resident of Colorado, Georgia and Illinois
- :: Have an cumulative, unweighted GPA of 3.5 or above
- :: Demonstrate financial need [annual household income no greater than \$70,000]

Applicants must also demonstrate the following:

- :: A strong interest and commitment to the community
- :: An ability to persevere through difficult circumstances
- :: Possess excellent leadership skills

HOW WE SUPPORT OUR SCHOLARS

We are not your typical scholarship program. Our unique Whole Person approach is designed to provide high-performing, under-resourced students with every type of support they'll need to succeed. Through our program, Scholars have access to as much personal, academic, and professional support as they do financial subsidies.



MENTORSHIP Our mentors are community leaders who guide, encourage, and inspire Scholars to achieve more than they could on their own. Scholars are matched with their mentor before beginning college and maintain the relationship throughout college and beyond.

PROFESSIONAL NETWORKING Scholars have access to successful role models and leaders from a variety of industries. These connections give Scholars the exceptional opportunity to explore career paths, conduct informational interviews, and gain insights into the professional world.

PEER SUPPORT Scholars are placed in structured peer advisory groups within the program. This provides them another avenue of support from fellow Scholars who better understand each other's unique challenges.

INTERNSHIP Internships provide real-world knowledge and increased confidence that cannot be gained in the classroom. We coach Scholars in finding and making the most of their internships.

SUMMER SYMPOSIUM The annual Greenhouse Scholars Summer Symposium is a world-class, multi-day gathering of all our Scholars. Workshops, speakers, panel discussions, and group projects allow Scholars to explore our core values and learn leadership skills.

FLEX FUNDING Scholars can apply for additional funds to support a wide range of projects, experiences, or specific unmet needs related to the vision and values of Greenhouse Scholars. Grants are made in amounts up to \$2,000.

TUITION SCHOLARSHIP We provide a four-year renewable grant based on each Scholar's individual financial circumstances and college expenses. Scholarships of up to \$5,000 per year are renewable for four years.
