

MOWR or DUAL ENROLLMENT COLLEGE CREDIT PROGRAMS

MOWR (Move On When Ready)/Dual Enrollment provides opportunities for Georgia high school students to earn college credit while enrolled jointly at Henry Grady High School and an approved in-state Georgia college or university. Once accepted, students may take advantage of a split schedule (half day at Grady/half day at the college) or be enrolled full-time at the post-secondary institution.

It's important to know...

- All students are subject to the admissions requirements as set for by the respective college to which they seek acceptance.
- Two applications required; online dual enrollment application via www.gafutures.org and an application to the specific college
- All students and parents must sign both the Grady HS Dual Enrollment Agreement and the standard Participation Agreement.
- Students accepted into a MOWR/Dual Enrollment program enjoy the same privileges and opportunities as those enrolled as college freshmen.
- Accepted students earn both 3 college credits and 1 unit of high school credit per class.
- For students accepted into the program, course tuition and books fees are paid by the Georgia Student Finance Commission.
- Students must meet Georgia residency requirements as well as U.S citizenship or U.S national/permanent residential status.

Grady's 4 most common MOWR/Dual-Enrollment options:

1. The Renaissance: On-site dual enrollment/MOWR

The *Renaissance* is located on Grady's campus so that students never have to leave our campus to attend their college classes. This is a partnership with Atlanta Metropolitan State College whereby the college's instructional staff facilitates classes on Grady's campus in our JROTC building Monday – Thursday. Eligibility Requirements:

GPA: 3.0 or 85%

ACT 20+ composite (17 minimum in English/Math sections)

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New Version SAT 760+ (minimum Reading 24 & Math 440/22)

Old Version SAT 970+ (minimum Reading 430 & Math 400)

2. Georgia State University (or other approved colleges): Off-site dual enrollment program

The traditional MOWR/dual enrollment program allows students to take advantage of a split schedule and attend the college for half the day, full day, or just one period. Students then leave Grady's campus to attend their college course(s). Whether the student attends the college for a half or full day, s/he is still bound by the requirements as established by Grady High School and the Atlanta Public School System. Typical courses taken at GSU are academic subjects i.e. English, Math, Science, Social Science, Foreign Lang, Fine Arts, etc. Contact your assigned counselor if you are interested in an off-site dual enrollment/MOWR program.

Eligibility Requirements:

GPA: 3.0 or 85%
ACT 23+ (23 minimum in English & Math sections)
or

New Version SAT 810+ (For GSU minimum Reading 29 & Math 560/28. For GSU Perimeter minimum Reading 26 & Math 530/26.5)
Old Version SAT 1060+ (minimum 530 in both Reading and Math)

3. The Career Academy at Atlanta Technical College: Offsite vocational-tech college enrollment

This is a partnership with Atlanta Technical College (ATC) whereby students attend Grady for half of the day in the morning, then travel to ATC's campus for the afternoon. Transportation is provided. Students have the opportunity to engage in technical courses such as Pharmacy Tech, Computer Information Systems, Automotive Collision Repair, Patient Care Assisting, Supply Chain Management, and other technical programs while attending ATC. Contact your assigned counselor if you are interested in the Career Academy.

Eligibility Requirements:

No minimum GPA but you must be in the 11th or 12th grade ACT 18+ or Old Version SAT (minimum Reading 410 & Math 410) New Version SAT (minimum Reading 23 & Math 450/22.5)

If you don't have an ACT or SAT score, then you can take Atlanta Tech's Accuplacer exam.

4. Georgia Institute of Technology (GA Tech): Off-site dual enrollment program

The traditional MOWR/dual enrollment program allows students to take advantage of a split schedule and attend the college for half the day, full day, or just one period. Students then leave Grady's campus to attend their college course(s). Whether the student attends the college for a half or full day, s/he is still bound by the requirements as established by Grady High School and the Atlanta Public School System. Typical courses taken at Tech are academic subjects i.e. Math (particularly Calculus) and Sciences.

Eligibility Requirements:

GPA: 4.0 or 98%

ACT 32+ (32 minimum in Reading, 34 in English, & 33 in Math)

or

New Version SAT 1470+ (minimum EBRW 710/38 & Math 750/37.5)
Old Version SAT 1430+ Reading & Math only (minimum 715 in both sections)
