The Program

The Global Youth Ambassadors Program's mission is to empower young people to become competitive in the global economy through preparation, scholarship, citizen service and international travel. This program educates youth leaders on social and economical challenges, seeks and recommends innovative solutions to the issues youth around the world face and encourage Youth Ambassadors to take action through service and diplomacy.

Youth Requirements

- •Be a high school sophomore, junior or senior in Spring 2016 in one of the following counties Fulton, Dekalb, Cobb, Clayton and Gwinnett
- Cumulative 3.0 Grade Point Average
- Obtain a valid passport within 3 months of program participation
- Have demonstrated leadership capabilities
- Have at least a "B" average or above in a foreign language
- Commit to a full term participation which includes Saturday leadership classes from 9am 3pm twice a month
- Student and parent/guardian must attend Parent/ Student orientation
- Student must have computer and internet access
- Must be able to travel for 2 weeks in the summer (dates to be determined)
- Provide an official school transcript (sealed/unopened)

Parent/ Guardian Requirements

- Parent/ Guardian is required to attend bimonthly parent meetings
- Parent/ Guardian is responsible for transportation to and from all program sessions and events (MARTA card will be made available to all students)
- Parent / Guardian must attend Parent / Student orientation

The program seeks a diverse group of students who have leadership qualities and potential. All applicants will receive notification of their application status upon review of complete application. Because the Global Youth Ambassadors Commissioners must reflect the depth and diversity of students in Fulton County, we regret that all qualified candidates are not always accepted into the program.

Program Commitments

Please be advised that attendance is required for Parent/ Student Orientation, all meetings, international trips, special events and volunteer events. Parent/ Student orientation- designed for all selected Global Youth Ambassadors and their parents to receive information about the program expectations and students responsibilities. The orientation also provides parents/ students with an opportunity to meet the staff and ask questions.



Each Ambassador is allowed 3 excused absences, 4 absences will constitute in termination from the program.

Volunteer/ Community Service Projects

Global Youth Ambassadors are expected to host 2 international service projects and participate in 4 international volunteer projects. This allows them to work with the international community at the grassroots level.

- 7. Should the new healthcare plan be offered to children with pre-existing conditions whose parents are illegal immigrants?
