IAHS parents are invited to join Sutton parents at the next Parent Education Series on December 4th at 7 PM in the Sutton Gym. The program will feature J.Tom Morgan's engaging presentation and discussion on Georgia laws and the impacts they can have on your teenager. With more than 10 years of experience in both prosecuting and defending teenagers, J.Tom Morgan has learned that many teens stumble into trouble without fully comprehending the law and its consequences. Mr. Morgan will be at Sutton to describe the ways specific laws in Georgia can impact teenagers and to share information and strategies to empower teenagers with the knowledge they need to avoid trouble. Mr. Morgan, the author of Ignorance is No Defense. A Teenager's Guide to Georgia Law, has appeared on CNN, the Oprah Winfrey Show, Court TV, the Today Show and 48 Hours. He served as the district attorney of DeKalb County for 12 years and was the first prosecutor in the state to specialize in the prosecution of crimes against children. He has spoken to tens of thousands of teenagers and parents regarding Georgia laws that impact young people and has listened to their stories. The insights he has gained from speaking with teenagers, as well as his experience as a prosecutor and private attorney, inspired him to write Ignorance is No Defense in which he explains Georgia laws in a readable, informative way using real-life examples.
