STRONG SCHOOLS START WITH ME!

Morningside's Go Team Meeting started at 5:30 p.m. and took place in the school auditorium. All members were present. Ms. Sofianos called the meeting to order. Quail Arnold Middlebrooks introduced herself as the APS district supporter. She will serve as an observer to make sure that meeting norms are followed. She also shared that the purpose of today's meeting is to appoint the community members and the swing seat member. She followed up with an overview of the agenda items and shared more general information about the procedural and functional aspects of the Go Team. We established that there is a quorum present so that voting can take place. Ms. Sofianos shared some about the nominating process and selection. Ms. Sofianos sent out several emails to interested candidates. She then interviewed four people over the phone. Ms. Sofianos shared that all community member nominees shared an interest in serving on the Go Team initially, but several candidates had chosen other schools or were no longer interested in being a community member of the team. The team was interested in knowing if there is a process for removal should a selected candidate prove a poor fit for the team. Karim Shariff was the nominee for the two year community seat. The team briefly discussed his profile. The team voted 6 to 0 to elect Karim Shariff for the two year community seat. The team decided that the vacant seats should be filled by community members as opposed to another parent or teacher so that we have a diversity of thought. Moving to the three year community seat, Lauren Parkerson was the nominee. After learning about her profile, the team voted 6 to 0 in favor of electing her to the three year community seat. Liz Davis was elected 6 to 0 to serve as the swing seat, three year commitment. Upon electing the new members, Ms. Sofianos shared that we need to sign-up for a Go Team orientation/training. Ideally, we would all attend the training together. Our first official meeting will take place in July. Ms. Sofianos motioned that the meeting be adjourned and the motion was seconded. Everyone said "good night" and left the auditorium.
