



Data Review

- Past and Current APS Calendars (SY 16-17 to SY 24-25)
- Survey Data (6,067 responses)

August-October Enrollment

- For the first few weeks of the year, enrollment is a better indicator than attendance
 - Attendance taking begins the first day a student shows up at school
- When we zoom in on enrollment from August-October, we see significant increases throughout August
 - Blue represents an increase in enrollments from the previous day, whereas orange represents a
 decrease
- By mid-September, numbers are relatively stable, and they stay that way throughout the year




Student Attendance by Day

- Average Daily Attendance is a measure of the percent of time that students are marked present for their scheduled classes
 - For elementary, this is by day
 - For middle and high school, this is by period
- Attendance is inflated the first 1-2 weeks
- Fridays generally have the lowest attendance, and a bit higher before breaks




Student Attendance by Week

 When you look at Average Daily Attendance by week, the effects of breaks on attendance are less pronounced



Teacher Attendance by Week

- When you look at Average Daily Attendance by week, the effects of breaks on attendance are less pronounced
- Attendance for Professional Learning days during breaks is good
- No major effects on the weeks before and after breaks, but what about late October?



Other Notes

- It's difficult to isolate calendar effects from other factors, particularly considering overall decreases in attendance
- Attendance among elementary school students and staff is best, followed by Middle and High
- Weighted survey results are under review, and we'll work to implement this in other applicable use cases going forward

Focus Groups Summary

- -Questioned how the calendar might influence student and staff attendance and outcomes
- -Start date suggestions ranged from August 1; Second week of August; Short week; full week
- -Clear support for **semester ending** before Christmas
- -Preference for **last day of school** before Memorial Day
- -Noted **positive impact of breaks** on students' and staff's mental well-being and focus
- -Exploration of **professional learning** during student breaks
- -Suggestions of calendaring parent teacher conferences connected with asynchronous days or ½ days
