Scroll down to the bottom of the page until you see:



Announcements: Allows a district to easily publish announcements, alerts and notifications via the My Schoolnet page. **Resources:** Allows a district to assemble and publish static and single sign-on links to other web sites, application and resources. **Notes:** Allows individual users to further customize their own My Schoolnet page with private notes.

Classroom Assessment Monitor: A new My Schoolnet web part, was added for all teachers and instructional managers. It provides teachers with zero click access to highly-visual benchmark assessment results for their students. It is located in My Schoolnet, not Align. Teachers see automatically; administrators have to choose a teacher in the Section Chooser




What You Can Do in the Benchmark and Classroom Test Tabs

From the Benchmark Tests tab and Classroom Tests tab main pages a teacher can do the following:

1. Use the color-outlined boxes at the top of the page to see the overall performance of a section on the most recent tests related to their sections.
2. Use the drop-down menu provided to shift to another test.
3. View a summary of the number of questions on the selected test, the number of tests submitted to date, and the proficiency percentage related to the test.
4. Use the colored vertical bar graphs provided for each student to track see individual performance on a given test, or drill down to a student's profile by clicking on a student's name.
5. Use the colored horizontal bar graph to view section, school, region/area and district results by score group.
6. Filter student results by separate score groups to focus on students with similar test results.
7. Use the links provided to jump to Standards Mastery, Skills Analysis and Item Analysis sections of the Align module related to the test.
