#### **CURRICULUM & CLASSROOM**

The SSEF funded more than \$117,000 in educational enrichment programs, materials and training. The following is a comprehensive list of investment areas funded to support our standard of excellence and benefit every student at Sarah Smith.



# ACADEMIC PROGRAMS \$46,875

The largest percentage of SSEF funding was Academic Programming. These dollars supported curriculum initiatives that further all Sarah Smith Elementary students' mastery of Math, Science, English and the Arts.



#### Classroom Libraries & Learningto-Read Resources .......\$2,456

Along with the media center, classroom libraries and the bookroom offer easy access to literary resources. These libraries boost literacy, reading time, and skills like fluency and comprehension. Funds cover books, leveled readers, and novels to support the Georgia Standards of Excellence and IB Inquiry-based Units.

# International Baccalaureate Inquiry Materials, Resources, Dues & Programming Fees......\$10,375

SRS received IB status in 2006, which promotes active learning, well-roundedness, and global citizenship. The IB program influences the entire curriculum at SRS, focusing on essential skills for learning and global citizenship. SSEF funds cover inquiry materials, teacher training, and program fees.
