

Credit Recovery Has Moved to Georgia Virtual School (GaVS)

GA DOE Credit Recovery Program courses have flexible schedules and are not facilitated by a teacher.

- The Credit Recovery Program allows students who have completed seat time and calendar requirements, to earn credit based on competency of the content standards.
- Credit Recovery courses are complete courses aligned to state standards, for which the student will demonstrate mastery before receiving a grade.
- The Credit Recovery Program offers core courses and limited electives, required for graduation from a Georgia public high school.

Credit Recovery Fee

All first-time enrollments are free to all public school students. Should a re-enrollment be required, a \$25 fee will be incurred.

Eligibility

- Any APS student who failed a course between 0-69 may enroll.
- The NCAA does not accept the GaDOE's Credit RecoveryProgram course credits for its student athletes.
 Therefore athletes cannot enroll in AVA.

How do Credit Recovery courses work?

- Students take a pretest at the beginning of each unit. If that score is 85% or higher, the student is allowed to proceed directly to that unit's post test.
- If the pretest score is less than 70%, the student must engage with every content item in the unit. When all items have been completed, the post test will be available to the student.
- In order to move out of one unit into the next, the student must score a 70% or higher on the unit post Only unit post tests/final exams/EOC assessments are recorded in the final grade. Students must complete the entire course and the final exam or EOC to receive credit for the course.
