September 2025 was one for the Books!! (Picture of Truist)



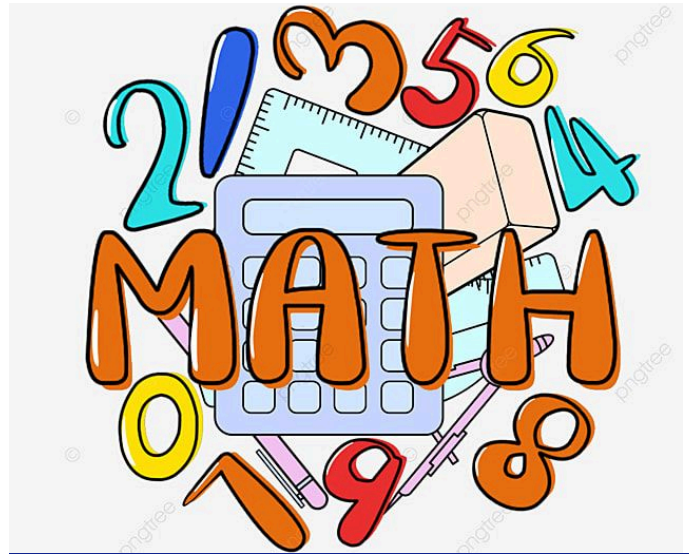
