As of the 12th day of school (August 16th, 2022), Infinite Campus reflected the actual enrollment for Dunbar Elementary was 261 students. Dunbar Elementary was under projected enrollment by -15 students, a lose of \$-52,232.35 would be required (at the SSF base per pupil amount of \$4,578) if we were to make adjustments based only on this data. 


