To ensure a smooth arrival to the McCamish Pavilion, we want to make sure guests are properly notified about the important details.

Ticketed Entry

Guests attending the ceremonies must present an official GRAD NATION ticket to gain entry. Ticket holders are required to sit in their assigned seats.

Clear Bag Policy

Guests must adhere to Georgia Tech's Clear Bag Policy. Please bring a small bag (no larger than 4.5" X 6.5") or a clear bag to the facility. A bag valet will be available for guests.

Stadium Security

Upon arrival, all guests are required to enter through security check points. Outside food, beverage, and weapons, including those carried with a permit, are not permitted.

Parking Information

A detailed parking map, which includes an area layout, pricing, and shuttle service locations for Georgia Tech campus parking decks is available for download on the district's graduation website. Guests may use the following parking lots upon arrival: Family Housing, North Deck (W23 Lot), Klause Lot, Peters Lot, and Tech Square Lot. Parking lot rates vary.

Venue Safety Precautions

We encourage all guests to follow COVID-19 recommendations set by the Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) while attending APS commencement events. These recommendations include wearing a mask based on preference and assessment of personal risk and practicing physical distancing (e.g., six feet) when around individuals not part of the same household or group. Any individuals who are sick, have a recent COVID-19 exposure or have a recent COVID-19 positive test should remain home and follow recommendations set by DPH.
