Introduction

A MESSAGE FROM KIPP METRO ATLANTA SCHOOLS

KIPP Metro Atlanta Schools have a dress code that provides guidance to scholars on the expected attire for school. Our dress code is designed as a visual representation of school pride and belonging. Our dress code has some elements of uniformity, while remaining largely **autonomous** and **flexible** so that scholars have opportunities for self-expression within each school's dress code.

The standards of dress have changed over the years, but it has always been the goal of schools to maintain an educational environment that is safe and beneficial to learning. Each KIPP Metro Atlanta School has a dress code. Each school's dress code includes a component of a school polo or KIPP shirt or KIPP outerwear which provides a code for each school to follow, however, there is not uniformity in the dress code across a school or across schools within KIPP Metro Atlanta. KIPP Metro Atlanta's dress code differs from a uniform policy, in that it still allows scholars some choice in what they wear to school.

In addition, the dress code is fundamental to helping scholars learn a life skill. School dress codes are great ways to teach scholars the importance of how to operate within societal norms, including a working environment.

The scholar Dress Code policy at KIPP Metro Atlanta is that **ALL** scholars are expected to wear the required Dress Code every day, unless otherwise indicated.

KIPP WOODSON PARK ACADEMY UNIFORM POLICY

The student dress code policy at KIPP Woodson Park Academy is that **ALL** scholars are expected to wear the required apparel each and every day, unless otherwise indicated. Scholars must wear the designated KWPA polo, KWPA shirt or KWPA outerwear as issued by the school or ordered online through our online vendor. Additionally scholars may choose to wear navy or black pants, skirts, shorts, or dresses. At a minimum, skirts and shorts must fall no more than 2 inches above the knees. If scholar bottoms are too short, families will be contacted to provide a change of clothes, if one is not available.

This guide will provide you with a detailed overview of the required dress code materials and the sample pairings for each look for grades K-8.

Scholar Paily Press Code

All K-8 scholars are required to wear the KWPA school polo or shirt corresponding to their grade-level, or as distributed by school.

• Kindergarten: **Burgundy**

1st & 2nd Grade: Hunter Green
3rd & 4th Grade: Royal Blue

• 5th & 6th Grade: Navy Blue

• 7th & 8th Grade: Black

*All K-8 families will receive an additional two shirts from the school in January

- *Kindergarten will receive a purple polo in March during their W.O.W. Ceremony
- *8th Grade will receive a teal polo in December during their W.O.W. Ceremony
- Required: navy or black pants, skirts, shorts, dresses, shoes with a closed-toe and fully closed heel
- Optional: KWPA sweatshirt, cardigan, varsity jacket, tights

Outerwear Options

We are excited to offer a variety of outerwear options! To complete the look (especially on those cooler days) scholars are permitted to wear a KWPA sweatshirt, cardigan, or varsity jacket. Additionally, long-sleeved shirts will be available for purchase throughout the 2024-2025 school year.

Dress Code Ports

The following are items **NOT permitted** as outlined in our dress code policy. For a list of permitted items please refer to **Page 3.**



NO tank tops of any kind



NO Non-School branded polos/t-shirts

*with the exception of special
dress down or spirit days.



NO leggings or tights as a replacement for pants



NO jeans of any kind



NO Crocs, sandals, slides, shower shoes, or flip-flops



NO hats, handkerchiefs, bandanas, or sleep headwear

*We honor head coverings for religious

and/or medical reasons.

How to Purchase

How do I order?

- When placing online orders, please input parent/guardian name at check-out. **DO NOT** put the name of the school in this portion.
