IB Mission Statement

IB stands for **International Baccalaureate.** Baccalaureate is defined as educational requirements set by standards of what international would mean, used by people of many nations. IB consists of four programs: The **PYP** (Primary Years Program) ages 3-12, **MYP** (Middle Years Program) ages 11-16, **DP** (Diploma Program) 16-19, and **CP** (Career-Relate Program). Dunbar is a **Candidate School** for the **PYP**. We are currently pursuing authorization as an IB World School.
