## What is expected of students?

Student Expectations

- Log into myBackpack every day.
- Check Edgenuity (and your Google Classroom or Microsoft Teams if your teacher has one) for important information, assignments and videos from your teachers.
- Read all related directions, links, documents posted in Google Classroom or Microsoft Teams.
- Actively participate every day.
- Engage politely, respectfully, and meaningfully online.
- Listen first and ask questions second.
- Complete all assignments and homework.
- Adhere to assignment deadlines.
- Collaborate with peers when asked to do so.
- Understand and agree all work submitted must represent their original ideas and/or they must appropriately cite all relevant resources.
- Email your teachers if you have any questions.
- Respond to their teachers in a timely manner.

#### Which courses should I be working on?


You should only be working on courses labeled Distance Learning.


#### Where do I go to see my grade?

You will see your Overall grade on your Course Tile upon logging into the Edgenuity portal. Your Overall Grade is an indication of how well you are performing in general on your coursework.



You want to make sure that you keep this grade above 80 if possible.


To determine your performance in each grade category, you will need to access the Progress Report icon in your Edgenuity course portal:

While you are waiting for your teacher to reset the assignment, please review the video material from the lesson and take notes on the material. Once the assignment has been reset, please go ahead and redo the assignment.
