

Getting Started

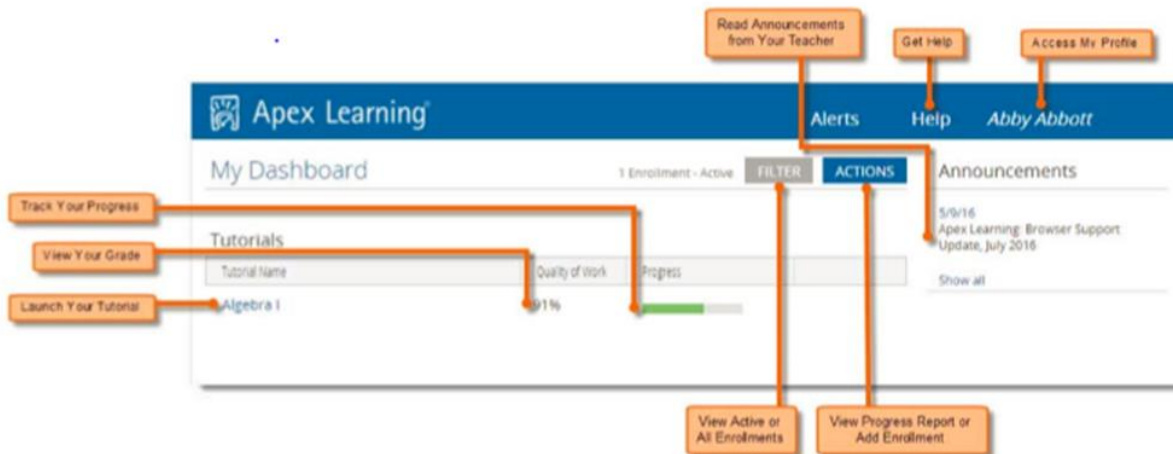
- Go to **www.apexvs.com**
- Click on Run System Check-Up. A pop-up displaying all green checks will indicate your device will support the APEX tutorials. If you do not receive all green checks make one attempt to log in. If you are unable to log in and/or see the lessons, then send a message to your teacher in google classroom to report the issue
- Log in with the username and password that you received from your teacher.



My Dashboard

After signing in, you are taken to My Dashboard where you can:

- Access your enrollments
- View progress information
- See important announcements posted by your teacher and by Apex Learning



- Your teacher will inform you of which assignments to complete. Please adhere to the teacher's' directions posted in Google classroom and/or told to you during the daily LIVE Sessions.

The Tutorial Window

The majority of your time will be spent working in the Tutorials window. Tutorials are organized as Units.



Unit Modules / Topics

Each unit has several Modules or Topics. Each Module has 4 activities:

- **Learn It:** Read and interact with the module topic.
- **Try It:** Practice and apply your skills with interactive practice questions.
- **Review It:** Watch a video to see how the module topic relates to the real world.
- **Test It:** Assess much you know about the module topic.

You have 3 attempts to complete a Test It. Depending on your program's settings, your individualized learning plan is automatically updated to reflect your Test It results.



Unit Posttest

After you complete all the modules in a unit — either by completing the Test Its or “testing out” of a module through the Pretest — your teacher may want to assess your knowledge by having you take a summative Posttest.
