COVID PROCTOLS

- Daily Student Temperature Screenings
- Daily Health Check App
- COVID Surveillance Testing
- Fogging machines will remain in place for cleaning and sanitation. • Standard nightly cleaning will continue
- Deep cleaning with the use of CDC-recommended disinfectants and fogging machines will take place in designated areas/classrooms/offices where there is a positive case of COVID.
- Hand sanitizing stations will remain in place and stocked in common areas and classrooms.
- Air purifiers in each classroom
- 3 ft social distancing when wearing masks.

COVID PROCTOLS (MASKS)

Masks Required

Universal Mask Wearing: Masks are **required** for all students and staff in all schools and buildings during the school and workday, as well as all indoor afterschool activities, clubs, and programs. Clear masks will be used serving students in special populations i.e., Deaf/Hard of Hearing, pre-kindergarten, and ESOL as needed. Exceptions should be made for persons who cannot wear a mask, or cannot safely wear a mask, because of a disability as defined by the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) (42 U.S.C. 12101 et seq.).



COVID PROCTOLS (MASKS)

School Buses: aligned with federal order and consistent with CDC recommendations regarding public transportation, all students and staff must wear masks when riding or operating school buses.

Outdoor Activities: Masks are optional for outdoor afterschool activities, clubs and programs. This includes outdoor play, recess, and physical education activities.

Cafeteria or Eating: Mask wearing is not required when eating; however physical distancing is necessary. Schools will utilize best practices for physical distancing in cafeterias and other areas where it would be difficult for students to wear masks.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT INTAKE & DISMISSAL?

Intake

- Students are able to enter the building at 7:15 and will be released to their classrooms. • Students may eat breakfast in the cafeteria between 7:15-7:40.
- Students are late and will be marked tardy after 7:45 a.m.
- Daily temperature checks will continue to take place at each entry point.

Dismissal

- All students will have a tag that identifies their method of transportation. Please help your student practice their bus color or car/walker number.
- All students will be reissued a car rider number and tag (orange)
- Sibling groups will share the same car rider number
- Car riders and walkers are called by number. For security reasons, parents must have car tags at walker and car-rider release areas.

DISMISSAL CHANGES

- Student safety is our #1 priority
- We are requesting that changes in transportation be for emergencies only.
- If an emergency arises, please communicate with the front office and directly with homeroom teachers before 1:30.

BREAKFAST, LUNCH & RECESS

Breakfast

- Students will have the option of eating in the cafeteria for breakfast from 7:15-7:40. If we reach capacity for social distancing, students will have to wait until space is available. Students who choose to eat breakfast after 7:40 will have to eat in their classroom.
- All breakfast will end promptly at 7:45

Lunch

• We will continue lunch in the classroom for the 1st quarter. We will reevaluate dining options at each quarter.
