Like so many others, I am heartbroken by the recent murders of eight people, six of whom were Asian women, at three different businesses in Georgia. On behalf of the Maynard H. Jackson High School community, I share our deepest condolences to the victims' families and friends. Furthermore, I know that this event has had a particularly profound effect on the Asian American community throughout the country, including here at MJHS. This unthinkable occurrence has brought to the forefront the xenophobia, racism, misogyny, and violence experienced by Asian Americans in our country. Please join me to stand in solidarity with our Asian American family in denouncing such hate and violence. We must all stand united against hate, in any form, as no people, and especially our children, should have to live in fear.
