





Right to Know Professional Qualifications of Teachers and Paraprofessionals

Date: 8/29/25

Dear Parents.

In compliance with the requirements of Every Students Succeeds Act, Atlanta Public Schools would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/ or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

- Whether the student's teacher—
 - has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
 - is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and
 - is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

If you wish to request information concerning your child's teacher's and/or paraprofessional's qualifications, please contact Deerwood Academy at 404-802-3300.

PARENT RIGHT-TO- KNOW

Tips for Families to Support ELA at Home


- <u>Read</u> Together: Read books, news articles, or stories. Ask questions about what they understood or liked best.
- <u>Writing Practice</u>: Short stories, journal entries, or even thank-you notes. It builds confidence and creativity.
- <u>Talk</u> About Their Day: Ask them to explain something they learned using full sentences.
- <u>Listen</u> to Audiobooks or Podcasts: This builds vocabulary and helps them hear how ideas are shared clearly.

PED POLICY (PERSONAL ELECTRONIC DEVICE) PROHIBITED USE OF CELL PHONE

Code 14F, APS Student Handbook, pg. 57

Students PreK - 12 are not allowed to use cell phones during the school day, once the bell rings. This includes class time, hallways, lunch, recess, assemblies, and free periods.


All personal devices must be turned off and kept out of sight.

If a student <u>wears</u> a smart watch or smart glasses to school, the device can not be used to make/receive calls. If a student <u>uses</u> a smart watch or smart glasses to make calls the rule will apply.

Exception: Students with an approved IEP, 504, or medical plan may use a phone only if it's clearly required in their plan.

What Happens If a Student Breaks the Rule:

- 1. First time: Verbal warning
- 2. Second time: Phone is taken and returned only to a parent during a meeting
- 3. Third time: Phone taken + no phone allowed at school for one semester
- 4. Fourth or more: Phone taken + no phone allowed at school for one year

How to Volunteer


