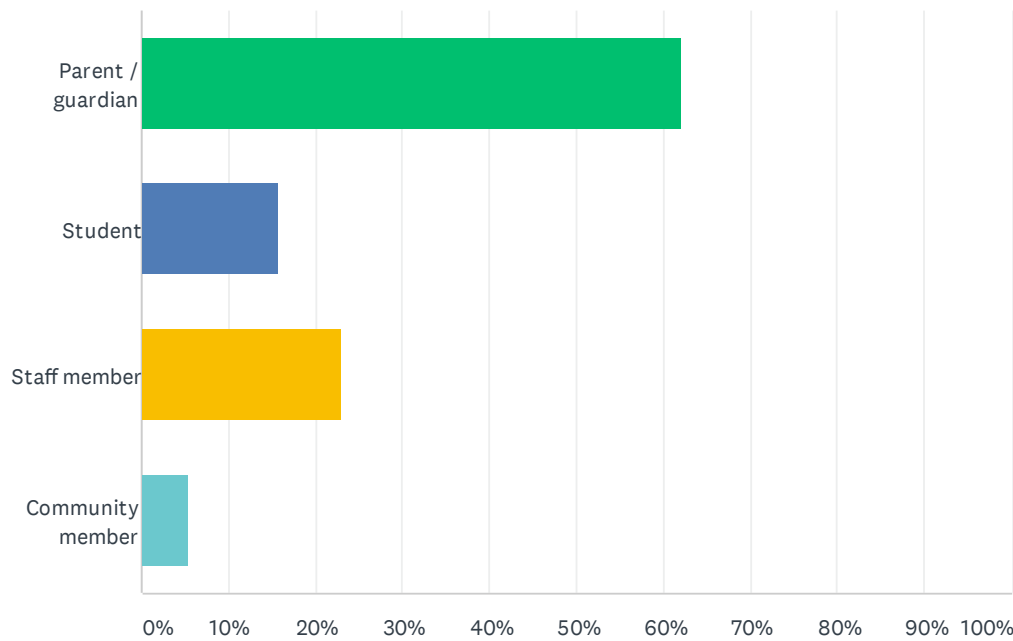


Q1 Please indicate your affiliation with Atlanta Public Schools (select all that apply).

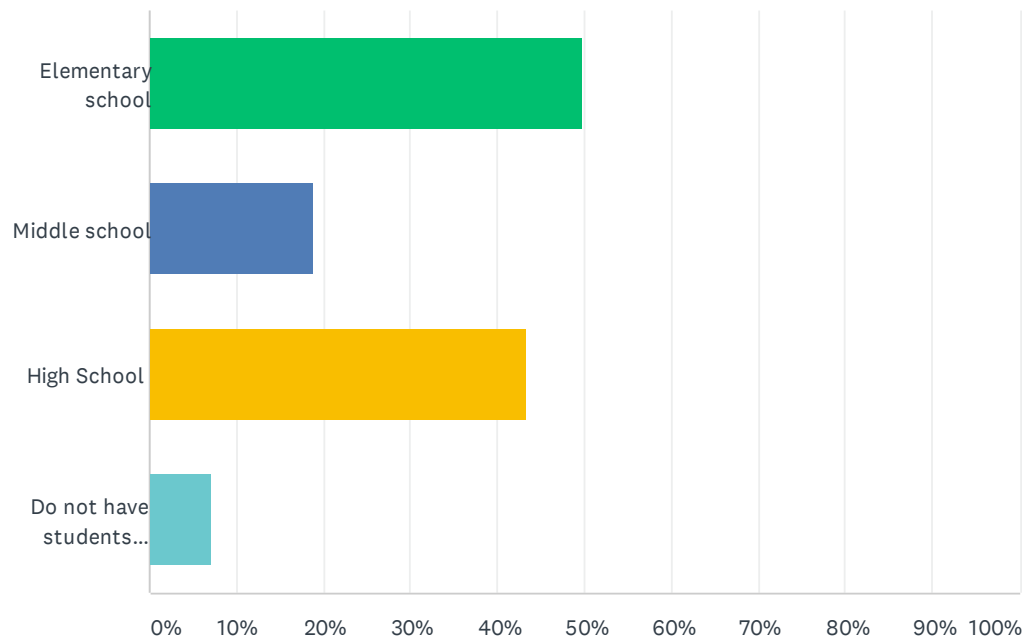

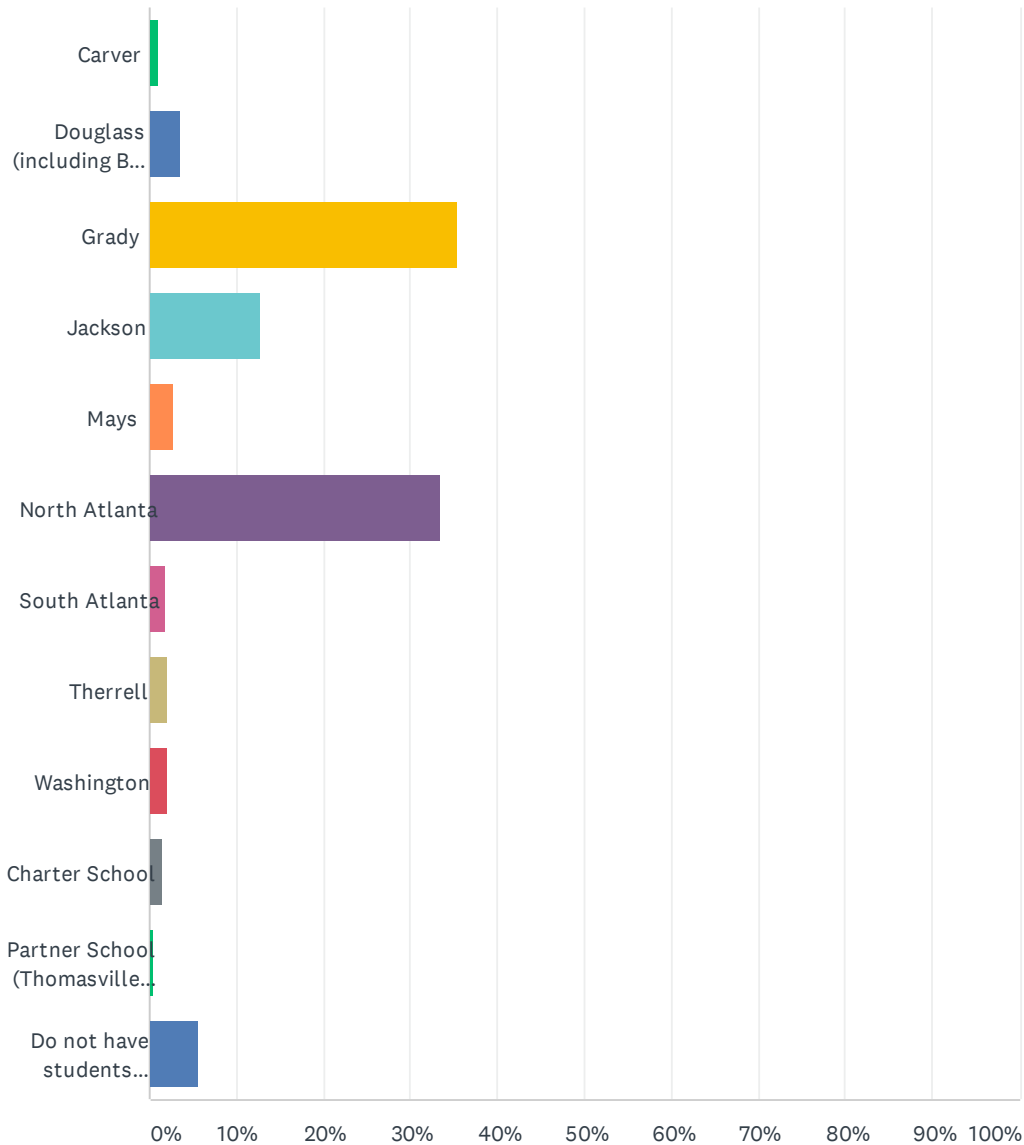

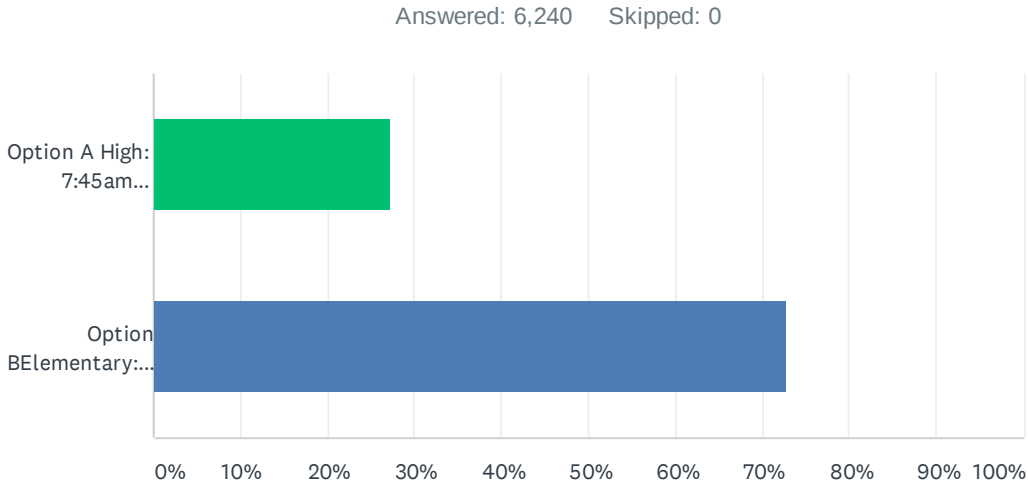
