Through the IB PYP Programme's commitment to transdisciplinary learning, students learn to appreciate knowledge, conceptual understandings, skills and personal attributes as a connected whole.



The transdisciplinary themes, that are used to organize the curriculum, mark the starting point of student inquiries. They provide authentic and real-life contexts for students to explore and engage with rich dialogues and ongoing collaboration to build an understanding of themselves, their wider community and the world.

Students reflect on the significance of their learning to take meaningful action in their community and beyond. Through this process of learning in the PYP, students

become competent learners who have the cognitive, affective and social tools to engage in lifelong learning.


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Community Connections

- Encourage your child(ren) stay in touch with relatives and friends who live in other countries by writing letters, using the phone or sending an email.
- ✓ Ask your child(ren) thought provoking questions and encourage them to discuss them with you. For example:
 - o Is there anything that you cannot buy with money?
 - o Why is the sky blue?
 - o Is slime a liquid or a solid?
- ✓ Work with you child to improve his/her listening skills. Being a good listener is an important part of communicating with others.
