It is my pleasure to serve as the Heritage Academy Gifted and Talent Development Lead Teacher for another wonderful year! We will have a lot of exciting learning experiences this school year. I have planned educational activities that will further enhance your child's mastery of Georgia's Standards of Excellence as we go above and beyond the regular curriculum. The students will have several opportunities to participate in educational activities and field experiences that explore our gifted standards. This year we are focused on being "Soaring Scholars."

We will kick off the year with Social Emotional Learning (SEL) activities as well as a return to Taking Wing (our birding curriculum) which will be infused throughout the school year. My 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> graders will explore animals in our first unit, "Zootopia".
