Welcome to another edition of Eagle News. As promised, each week you will receive this special update along with loads of information regarding what is going on in our school. To ensure that you are up to date, Here are a few of this week's reminders:

## MAP Assessment

Next week our scholars will begin their fall Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment. The testing window began on **Monday**, **August 19**, **2024**, and runs until **Friday**, **September 6**, **2024**. Our Kindergarten through 4th grade scholars will complete the assessments for Reading and Math and our 5th grade scholars will take the Reading, Math and newly added Science assessments. The MAP Assessment helps your scholars' teachers determine what your scholars already know, what they need to learn next and what they may need to be taught again. In order for our teachers to collect the best data, it is extremely important that scholars are present and on time each day during the testing window and that they do their very best.

## **School Picture Day**

We will take our school pictures on Monday, August 19, 2024 during the school day. We are asking that scholars come dressed in our Dress for Success Uniform or BaMO Uniform. We have a limited supply of ties and skirts available for sale in the front office.

## Important Information Regarding Dyslexia Screening

Dear Parents and Guardians:

In accordance with Georgia Senate Bill 48, Atlanta Public Schools has a screening process to identify students in kindergarten through third grade for characteristics of dyslexia. This letter is to inform you about the process and your right as a parent.

## What is dyslexia?

Dyslexia is a specific learning disability that is neurobiological in origin. It is characterized by difficulties with accurate and fluent word recognition and by poor spelling and decoding abilities. These difficulties typically result from a deficit in the phonological component of language that is often unexpected in relation to other cognitive abilities and the provision of effective classroom instruction.

## What does screening involve?

The dyslexia screening process must include tools that assess phonological awareness and phonemic awareness, sound symbol recognition, alphabet knowledge, decoding skills, encoding skills, and rapid automatic naming.

APS uses NWEA MAP Dyslexia Screener as its dyslexia screening process. View our reading and dyslexia screening process here.

## Your Right to Opt-Out

While we encourage participation in this important screening, you have the right to opt your child out. If you choose to do so, please sign and return this letter by Friday, August 16, 2024.

## **What Happens Next?**

School teams will use the Multi-tiered System of Supports (MTSS) framework to review screening results and identify intervention needs. You will receive results from the screener and notification or if your child is at risk or not at risk of reading challenges. Students who are identified as being at risk for reading challenges may receive additional support and monitoring.

## Right to Know Professional Qualifications of Teachers and Paraprofessionals

August 14, 2024

Dear BaMO Parents,

In compliance with the requirements of Every Student Succeeds Act, Barack & Michelle Obama Academy would like to inform you that you may request information about the professional qualifications of your student's teacher(s) and/ or paraprofessional(s). The following information may be requested:

- Whether the student's teacher
  - o has met State qualification and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction;
  - o is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification or licensing criteria have been waived; and
  - o is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether the child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.




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

Dear BaMO Parents,

Our fall Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment testing window opens soon, and we are making final preparations for a successful testing season. Our testing window begins *on Monday, August 19, 2024*, and closes on *September 6, 2024*. As we prepare for your scholar to take this assessment, we wanted to share some information with you.

The MAP Assessments is a short test that provides teachers with learning data in reading and math. They are computer adaptive, which means that questions adjust to each answer that your scholar provides. The data from this assessment will help your scholar's teacher determine what your scholar already knows, what they need to learn next and what they may need to be taught again.

BaMO scholars in grades Kindergarten through Fifth Grade will be completing the MAP Assessment in Reading Math. This year our 5<sup>th</sup> graders will also take the MAP Assessment in Science. In order for our teachers to collect the best data, it is extremely important that scholars are present in school each day during the testing window. Below are a few things that we are asking that you help us to ensure that your scholar does their best on this assessment.

- Ensure your scholar is present every day and on time for school.
- Ensure that your scholar has a good night's sleep.
- Talk to your scholar about doing their best on the test.

Our goal is to receive the most accurate data to assist us in planning the best instruction possible for them. Remember that the data from the MAP assessment assists us in ensuring that the instruction that your scholar is receiving meets their individual educational needs.

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
