How can parents help to develop students who are Communicators at home?

1. Talk about the day's activities.
2. Explore other forms of communication in addition to speaking.
3. Talk with your child about the books you read together.

5. Keep books, magazines, and other reading material where kids can reach them ~without help.
6. Listen to your child when he/she talks with you.
7. Ask questions about what they are saying, ask for explanations.
8. Act out stories, plays, poems, use language in fun creative ways.
