We have innumerable lessons and activities planned for this school year that will incorporate cross disciplinary studies as mandated by the Georgia Standards of Excellence. At Sylvan Hills Middle School, many of our activities are self-paced and student-directed. Our GATE learning format is a combined pull-out resource and collaboration model. This model allows students to spend up to 5- segments/week interacting with their intellectual peers while being taught by a gifted certified teacher.
