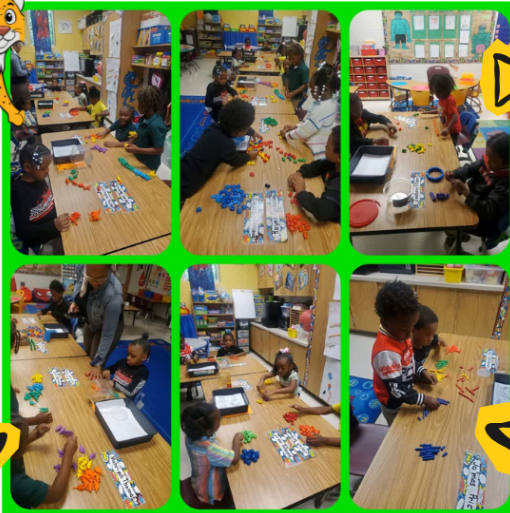

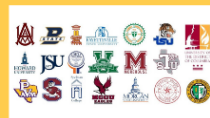

To celebrate and encourage strong attendance, we'll have special prizes, raffles, and fun surprises for students AND parents throughout the month. Stay tuned for more details!

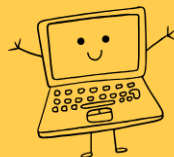

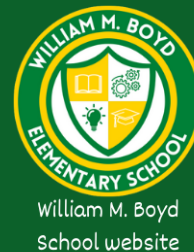
