The Road to Graduation: Student Attendance and Punctuality

- All students must attend school daily. Attendance impacts grades.
- Make it a priority to get to every class everyday on time. School begin at 8:45 and end at 3:45. 6 minute transition between each class.
- Tardy Sweeps occur each period. If students are not seated by the bell, they must have a pass to enter class.
- Students arriving late to school must receive a tardy pass. Out zone students are subject to withdrawal.


Expectations for the Scholar
