### **Data Clarification**

Recently, a community member raised concern over a data point shared during our Virtual Open House. We shared with you "an increase of about 22% in students scoring proficient or above on the Accelerated Algebra EOC (End of Course) [test]." The concern was we did not include every student who took the EOC during the Winter.

As is the case every year, both first-time test takers and students repeating courses take the EOC. When we reported this data point, we only intended to show success for our first-time test takers - students enrolled in an Accelerated Algebra I course from August to December - and compare them to the same students from the previous year.

We regret any misunderstanding this may have caused, but it was always our intent to identify this successful event in the way we did. Our effort was to show the success of only our first-time test takers - our Accelerated Algebra I students in this case. This is no different from how data are reported year after year during testing season.
