# Copyright Laws/Fair Use Policies

#### You can:

- Upload a recorded read aloud to closed educational platforms such as Microsoft Teams, Google Classroom, and Zoom.
- Secure permission from the publisher and read the permission statement prior to reading the book aloud.

#### You can't:

- Upload a recorded video to a public YouTube channel. All YouTube channels must be **UNLISTED.**
- Maintain live events archived on a social media platform. After 24 hours, appropriate measures should be taken to ensure that videos of the live events are not retained.
