MyOn

MyOn is a district reading initiative which really makes a difference with struggling readers. This app is located in MvBackpack which is available to students anywhere they can log on to the internet. There are over 6.000 titles that are recommended to students based on their reading level. At the students' initial login they are asked a series of reading diagnostic questions. An approximate reading lexile score is calculated. Students can read books on their level which gives the opportunity to improve. They can read independently or listen to the stories. This is a great tool for readers of all levels.
