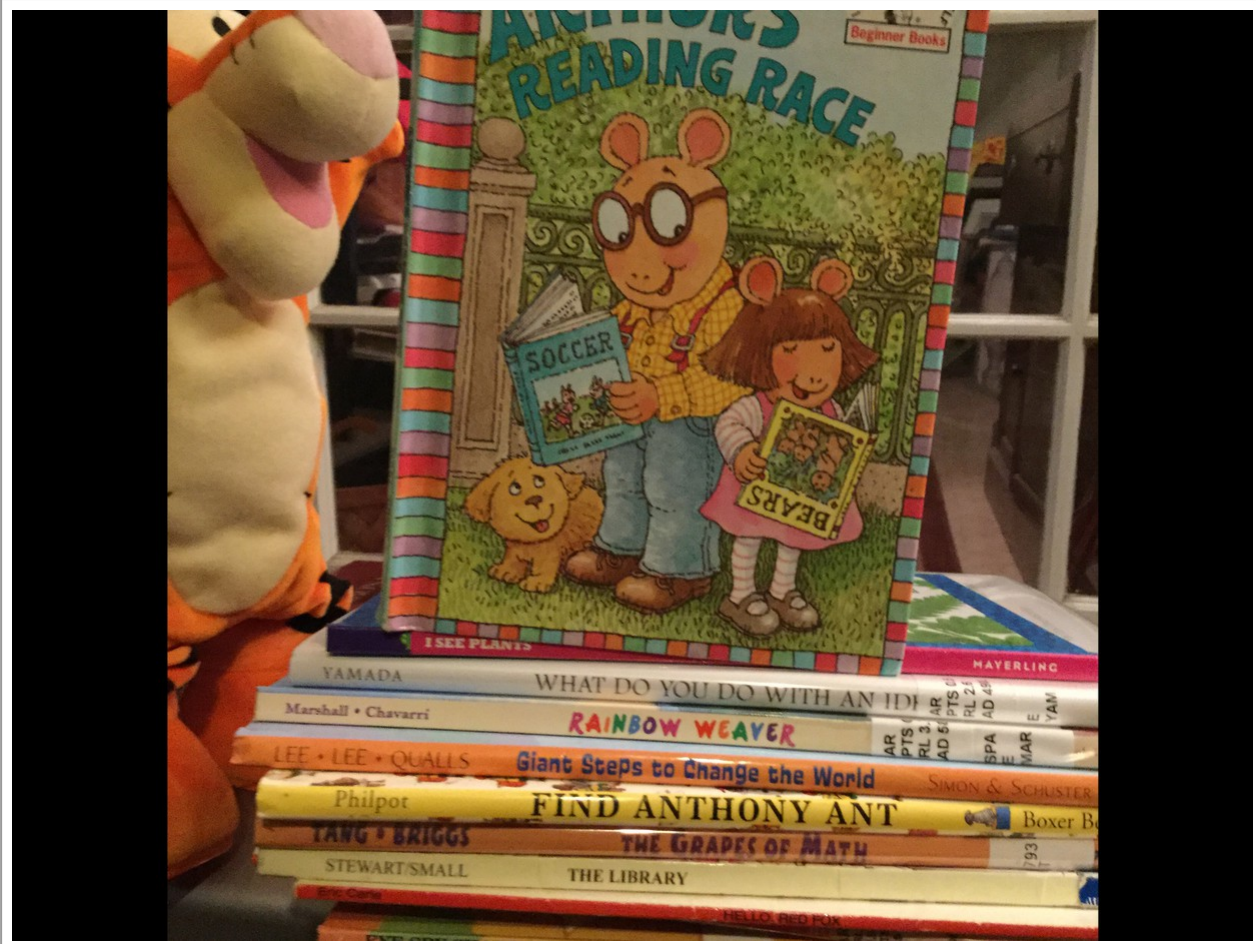
## SUMMER READING

Fortunately for us in Atlanta Public Schools, we can continue to record what we read using our Beanstack **Race2Read** logs, because the program is attached to the public library as well and we can still take **AR** quizzes.

All of the Atlanta Public Schools' students and staff have access to the Fulton County Library resources by way of the **AFPLS Class Pass** app on **myBackpack**. Please take a look at information regarding Class Pass at the end of this newsletter. The **student credentials** include their network ID, i.e. jdoe1234; and their password is usually their lunch number. Contact the student's homeroom teacher for their credentials.

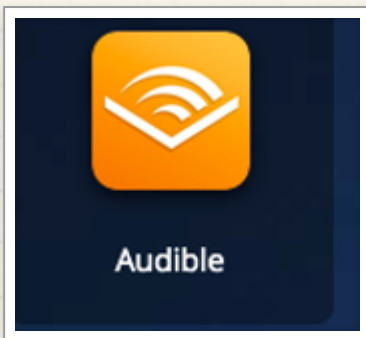
## CES Tigers' Summer Reading Challenge 2020

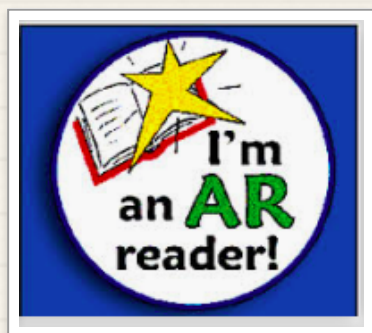
## Audible

**It's that easy.**



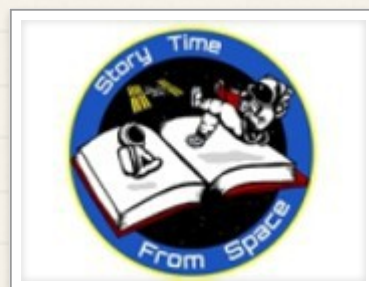

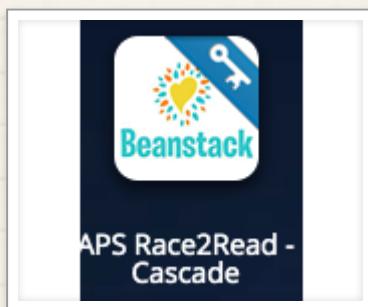

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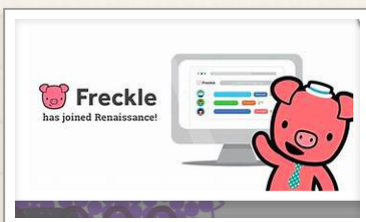
