
### **PROCESS**

- □ Proof of legal guardianship (if applicable).
  - Only required if your name is not on the child's hirth certificate
- □ Parent/guardian I.D.
  - State LD passport or driver's license
- □ Proof of residency
  - Lease, mortgage statement, or utility bill in parent/guardian name (cable and phone bills are not accepted)
  - If you are living with someone and do not have a lease or utility bill in your name, you will need a notarized affidavit of residency, three forms of ma in your name AND the most recent lease/utility bill in the name of the person you are living with.

- ☐ Child's original social security card
- □ Child's health insurance card
- ☐ Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable) Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
- □ Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
