PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- Child must turn four years old by September 1, 2025
- Child must live within the APS attendance zone

- **Pre-K lottery applications accepted February 17 through March 10, 2025**
- Apply online at <https://apsprekapp.schoolmint.com> starting at 9 am (eastern time) on February 17, 2025
- A valid email address is required to apply
- Applications must be received by 11:59 pm (eastern time) on March 10, 2025

- **The lottery drawing will be held on March 24, 2025**
- Lottery drawing results will be emailed to all applicants after verification process. Pending official verification, lottery results could be delayed.

THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS ARE REQUIRED FOR ENROLLMENT:

- Child's original birth certificate or passport
- Child's original social security card or waiver
- Proof of legal guardianship (if applicable).
 - Only required if your name is not on the child's birth certificate
- Child's health insurance card
- Parent/guardian I.D.
 - State I.D., passport, or driver's license
- Proof of food stamps, Medicaid, TANF (if applicable)
- Proof of residency
 - Immunization certificate (Form 3231)
 - Ear, eye, and dental screening (Form 3300)
 - Proof of income – **Head Start sites ONLY****
 - 2024 W2 or 1040 tax return, 2025 SSI/TANF SNAP Award or Determination Letter (must show monthly payment).
 - If in 2024 you did not work or file taxes, a non-income declaration form will be provided to you.
 - Lease, mortgage statement, AND Georgia Power bill in parent/guardian name (cable, phone, water, and gas bills **are not** accepted)
 - If you are living with someone you will need the following:
 - A valid lease/mortgage statement **AND** Georgia Power bill in the homeowner's name
 - Affidavit of Residency
 - Three forms of mail in your name with the homeowner's address
