Welcome to Perkerson Elementary's Gifted and Talent Development Education (GATE) 2023-2024 school year! We are excited to welcome you back for another wonderful year of teaching and learning in EXCELLENCE! Our theme for this year is, Making Connections: Past, Present, Future.

We have innumerable lessons and activities planned for this school term that will incorporate cross disciplines in all areas of studies as mandated by the Georgia Standards of Excellence. In addition, we will focus and include assignments and activities that touch on the eight Gifted and Talented Program Standards; Advanced Communication Skills, Creativity, Creative Problem Solving, Global Citizenship, Higher Order Thinking Skills, Leadership, Advanced Research Skills, and Social Emotional Learning.

At Perkerson Elementary, many activities are self-paced and student directed. Our GATE learning format is a combined pull-out resource and collaboration model. This model allows students to spend up to 5- segments/week interacting with their intellectual peers while learning from a gifted certified teacher.
