#### What is it?



# **CAES Goals**

By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 21% of 3rd-5th grade students will score Proficient or above on the ELA GMAS, an increase from 16% in 2024-2025.

By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, 24% of 3rd-5th grade students will score Proficient or above on the Math GMAS, an increase from 19% in 2024-2025.

By the end of the 2025-2026 school year, the percentage of students absent less than 10% of the enrolled days will increase from 58.2% (2024-2025) to 63.1% (2025-2026).
