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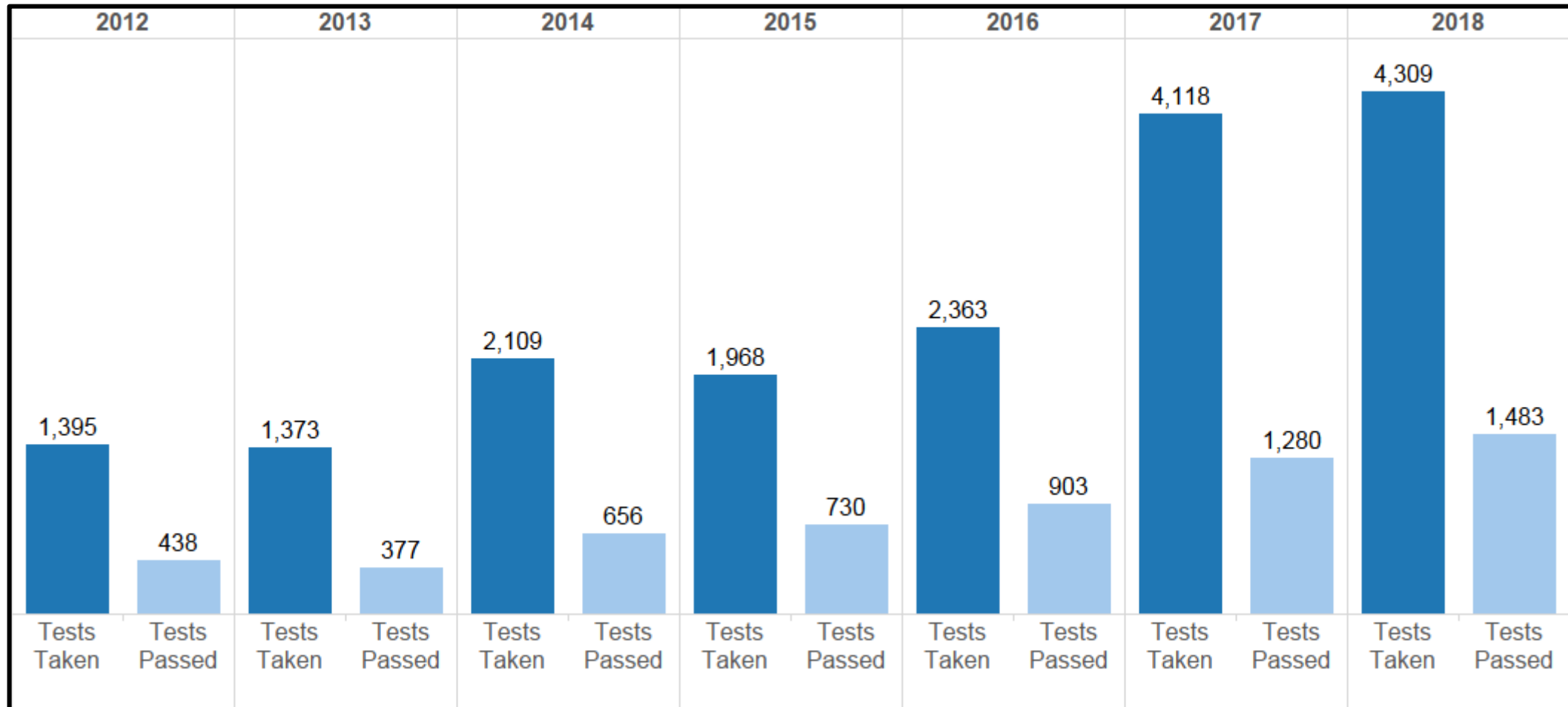

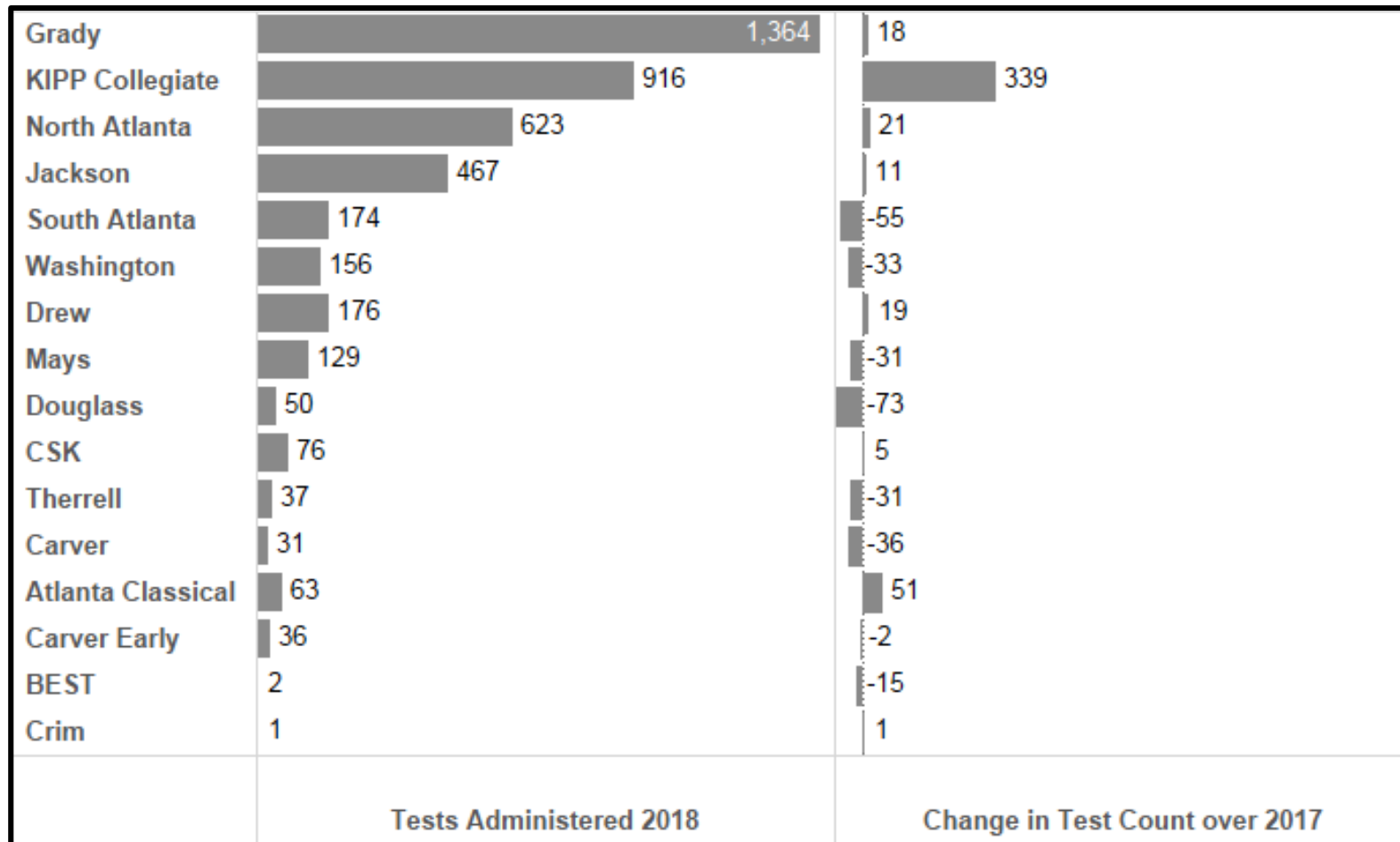
Advanced Placement Tests Taken and Tests Passed (score of 3, 4 or 5) 2012-2018

APS saw an increase (+191) in the number of Advanced Placement (AP) tests administered in 2018. The total number of tests passed also increased (+203).



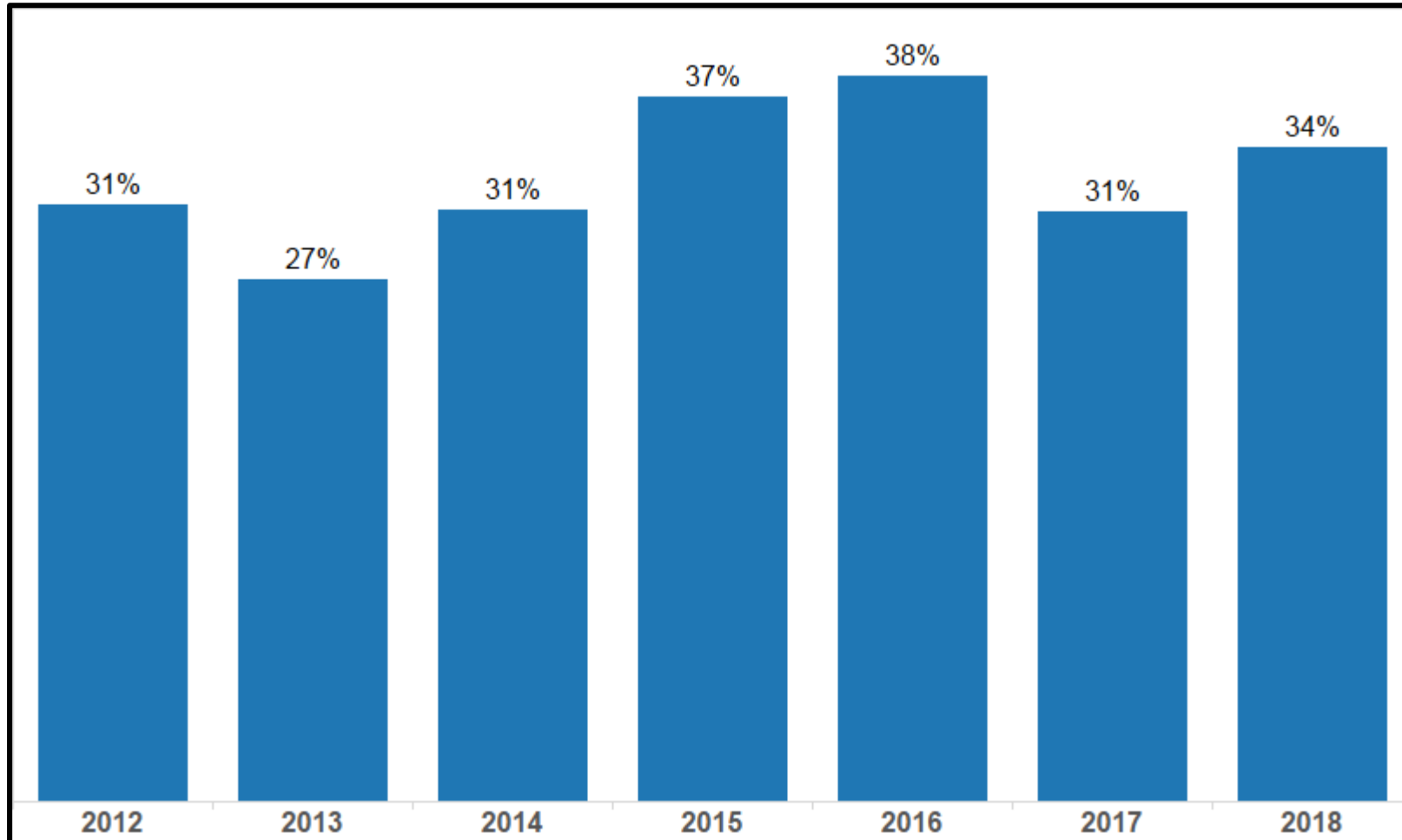
Count of 2018 AP Tests Taken by School; Change in Test Count Compared to 2017

Grady administers the highest number of AP exams in the district. KIPP Collegiate had a large increase (+339) in the number of AP exams administered when compared to the previous year. While the total number of AP tests administered district-wide went up, eight schools (more than half) had a decrease in tests administered.



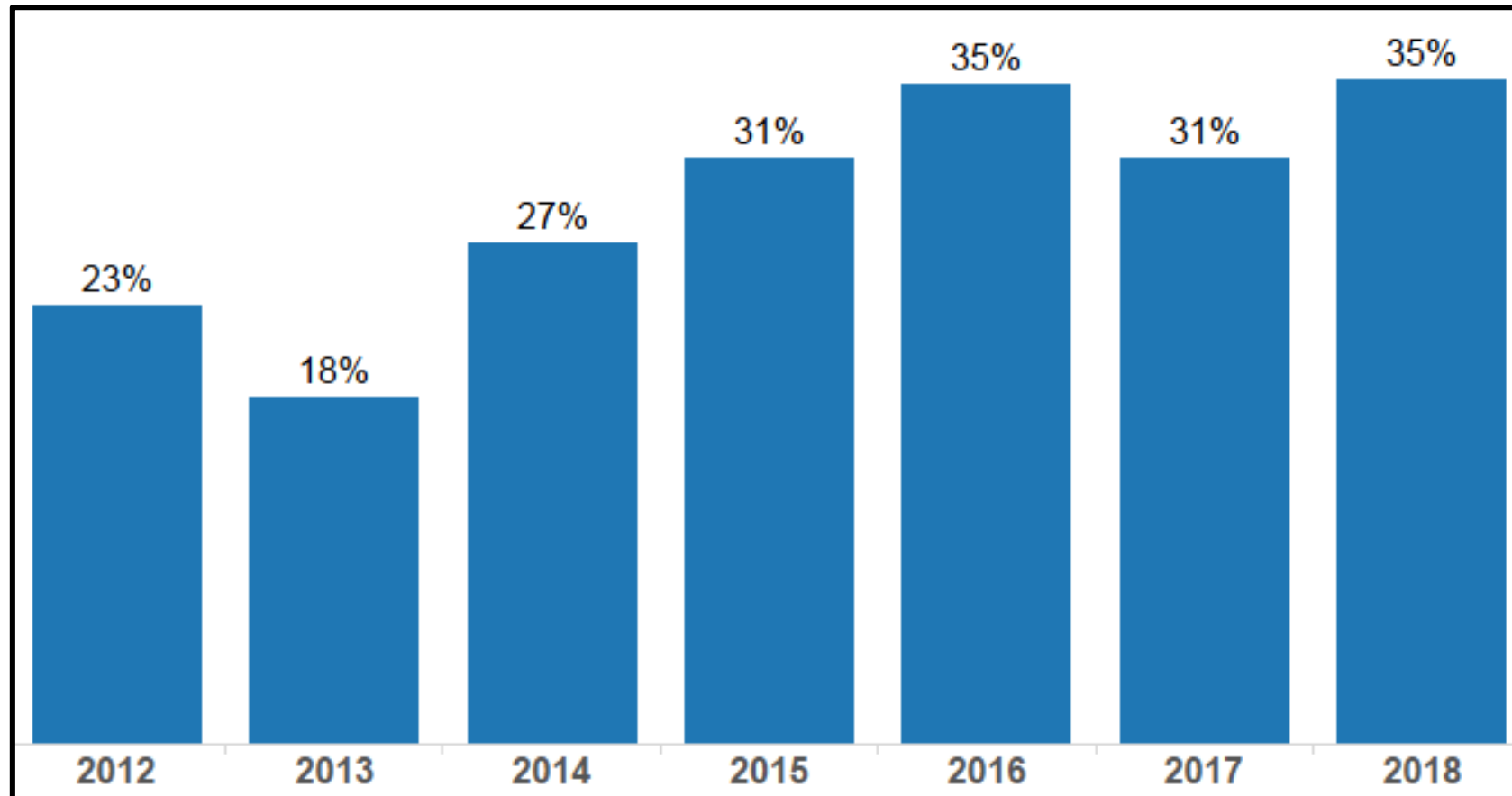
AP Test Pass Rate, 2012-2018

Thirty-four percent of AP tests taken were passed (a score of a 3, 4, or 5). This is up three percentage points from the previous year. The district saw a large increase in the number of tests administered between 2016 and 2017, which contributed to the drop in pass rates between 2016 and 2017.



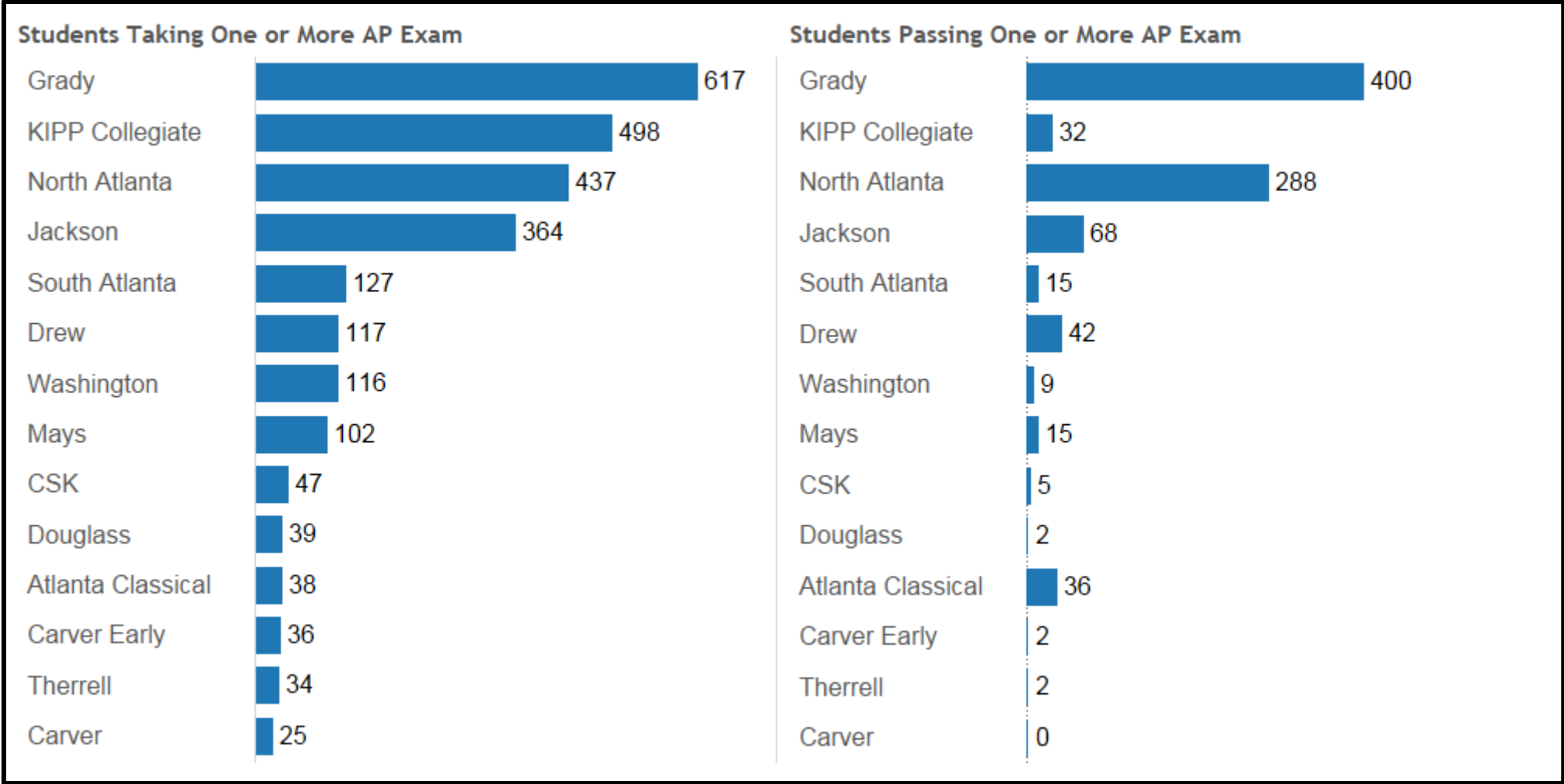
Percent of Students Passing One or More Attempted AP Exam, 2012-2018

Some students take multiple exams. Thirty-five percent of individual students who took an exam passed at least one of them in 2018.



Counts of Students Taking 1+ AP Exam and Students Passing 1+ AP Exam, 2018

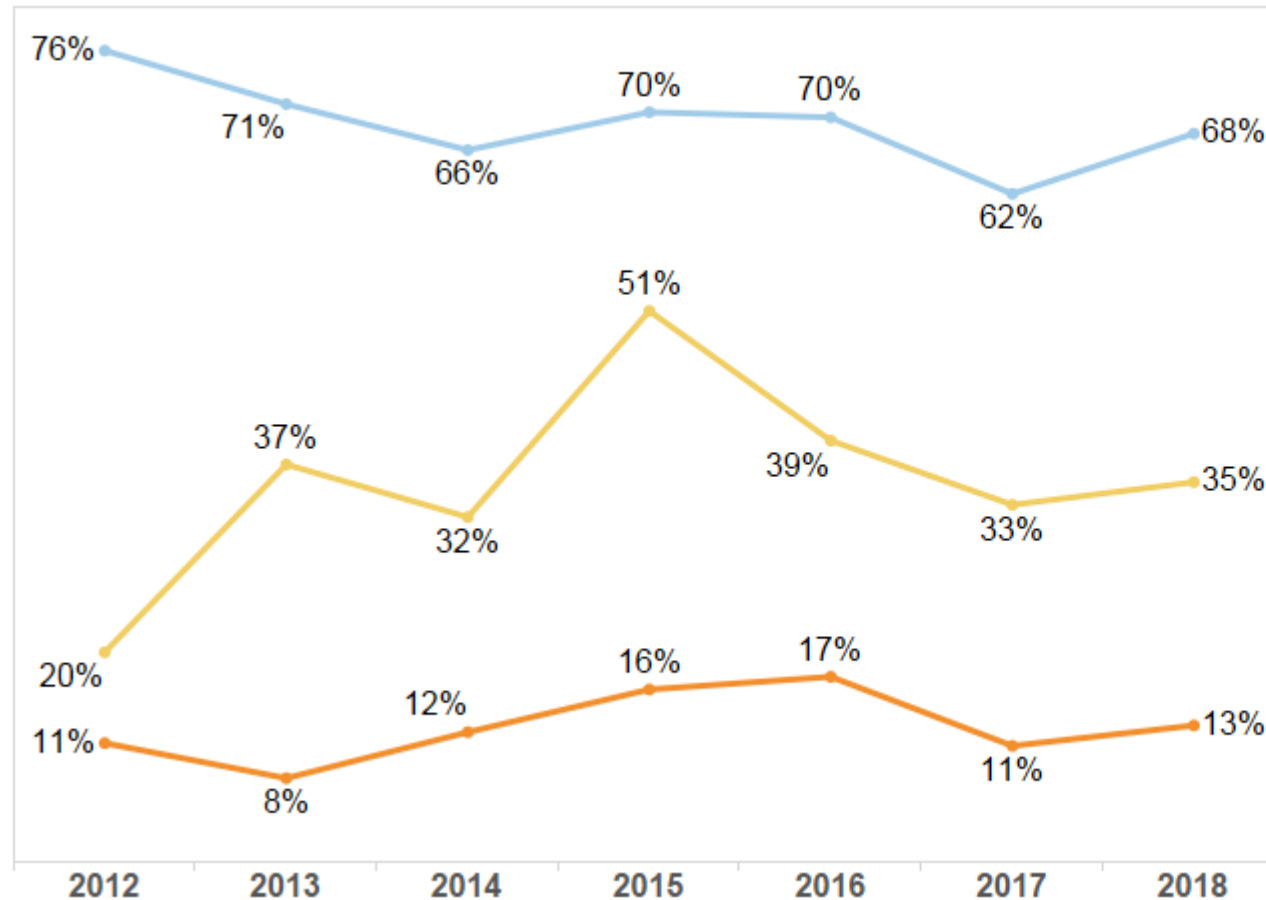
While students taking AP exams were spread out across the district, the majority of students passing AP exams were concentrated at a few schools.



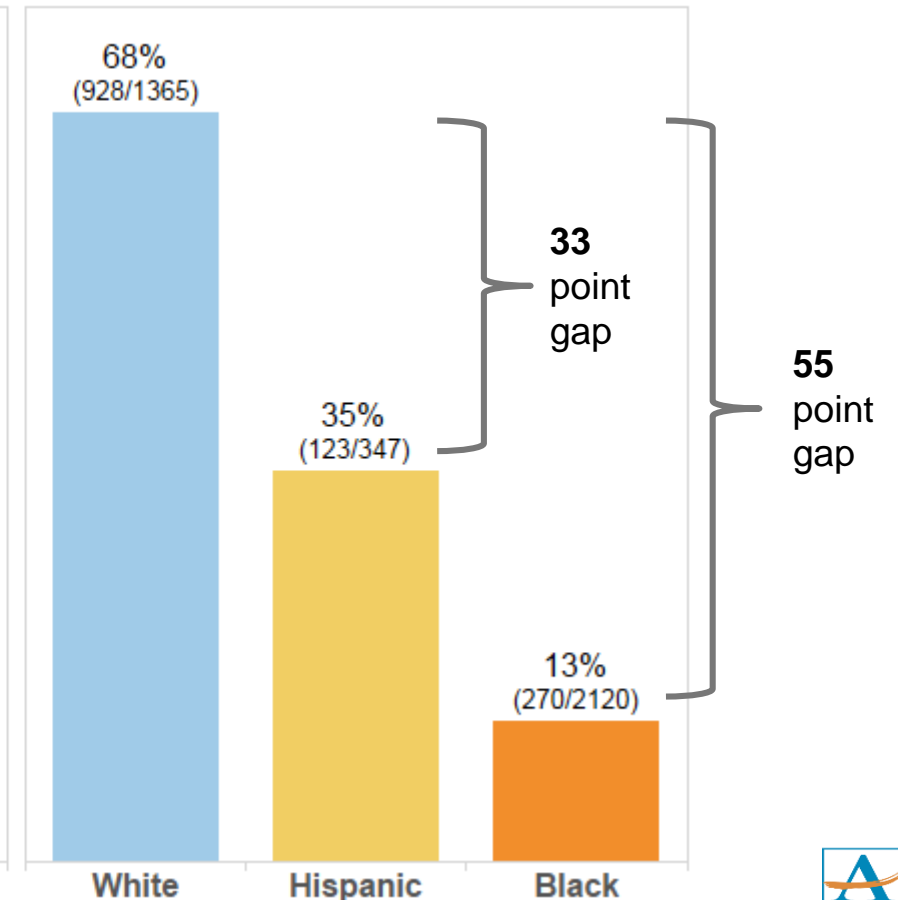
AP Test Pass Rates by Race, 2012-2018

The percent of tests passed differs dramatically by race. In 2018, the percentage of tests passed by white students was 55 percentage points higher than the pass rate for black students.

Test Counts and Pass Rates by Subject, 2017-2018

Social Studies and English were the most tested subjects.

Pass rates vary greatly. Of subjects in which more than 100 APS students were tested in 2018, Seminar had the highest pass rate (67%) and Statistics had the lowest pass rate (10%).

U.S. History had the largest increase in test takers (up to 623 from 444).

Pass Rates and Test Counts by School, 2015-2018

At the school-level, the percent of tests passed ranges from 92 percent (Classical) to zero. Cases where fewer than 10 tests were administered have been excluded.

Classical, Grady, North Atlanta, Mays, Jackson, South Atlanta, Washington, and Douglass saw an increase in their pass rate when compared to the previous year.

Student Body Taking an AP Course, an AP Exam, and Passing an AP Exam, 2018

Looking at the student body as a whole helps us understand what percentage of APS students are taking, testing and passing AP exams, rather than focusing on just students who took take AP tests.

KIPP had the highest percentage of the student body taking an AP course at 70%, but only 4% of their student body passed an AP exam.

Classical, Grady, Drew, and North Atlanta all had more than 10 percent of their student body pass an AP exam.
