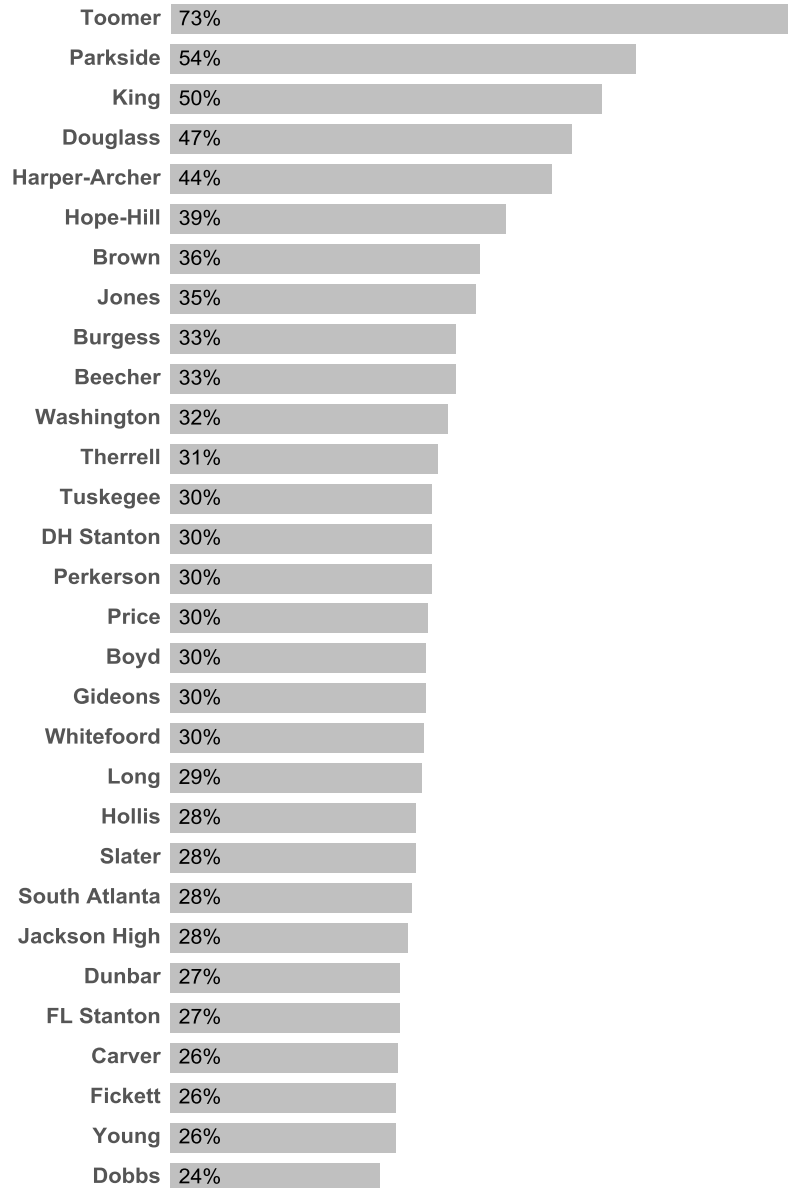


APS Zoned School Enrollment, 2016-2017

The percentage of students attending their local zoned school varies widely by school, mostly driven by the availability of other local options. The graph below show the thirty schools with the largest percentage of zoned students who do not attend the school. 73% of elementary students who are zoned for Toomer do not actually attend Toomer.

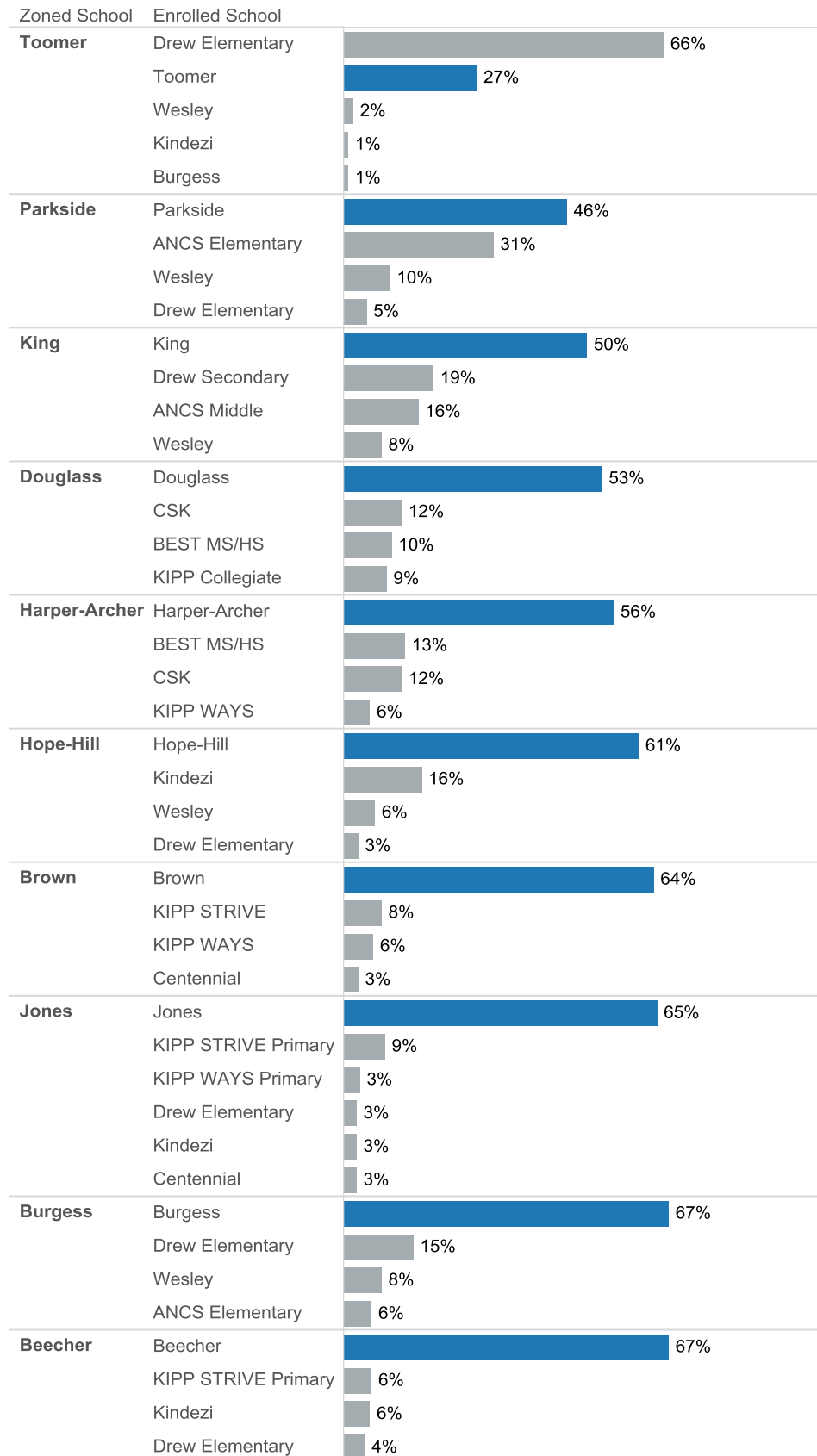
Figure 1: Percentage of APS students who do not attend their zoned school, by zoned school



The data for this report is based on Infinite Campus addresses and enrollment in Infinite Campus, pulled on 8/29/2016.

The next figure focuses on the ten school zones with the largest percentage of students attending out of zone. For each of the ten school zones, the four most commonly attended schools are reported. This shows that Toomer is the only school zone where the zoned school is not the most attended school.
