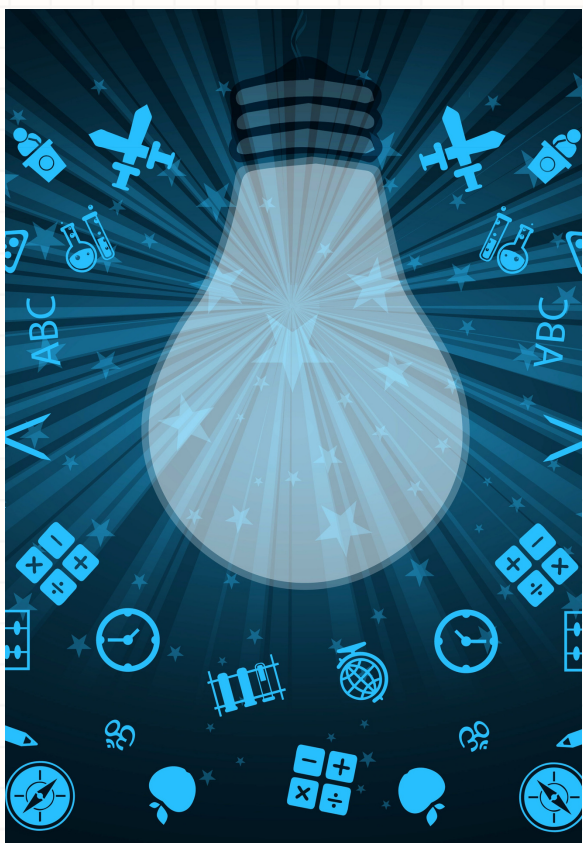

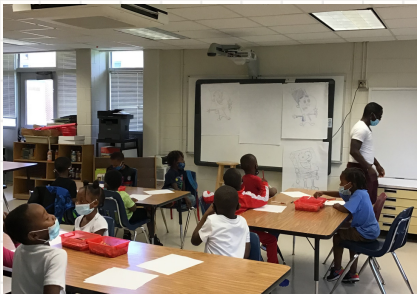


TEACHER HIGHLIGHT

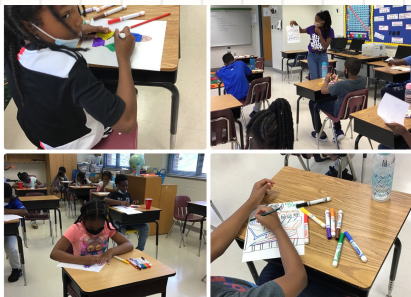
