



Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program

FY 2023 LIHEAP HEATING

Program Description

The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) is available to all income eligible households in Fulton County and City of Atlanta. This program offers a payment of \$350, \$450, or \$500 once per program year to be applied to your home energy bill.

FACAA offices are closed to the public. All appointments will be conducted over the phone.

Required documents include:

- Current gas bill <u>and</u> electric bill (Must show your name, full address, account number and amount due.)
- Proof of income for the last 30 days for all occupants over 18
- Social Security cards for all household members
- Valid Photo ID (Driver's License, Permanent Resident Card, Passport, etc.)

TO PREVENT DELAYS IN PROCESSING YOUR APPLICATION:

 Drop your documents off at 341 Kelly Street, Monday – Thursday from 10:00 am to 2:00 pm

(You <u>Must</u> Have an Appointment to Drop off Documents)

Or upload your documents one week before your appointment

When can I apply?

Tuesday, November 1, 2022 Senior households (65+)

Thursday, December 1, 2022

Appointments open to all eligible households
