





#### Your child, \_\_\_\_\_\_, was a close contact to someone diagnosed with COVID-19 and should guarantine for 10 days.

A close contact means being within 6 feet of a person with COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more OR having direct contact with a person with COVID-19 (e.g. being coughed on, kissing, sharing utensils or water bottles, etc.).

This letter is being sent for your information. On \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ we learned of a student/teacher/staff member who tested positive for COVID-19. We have been working closely with the local public health department to make sure the student/teacher/staff with COVID-19 is isolated, close contacts are identified, and the school is cleaned and disinfected.

#### At this time, your child is <u>NOT</u> a close contact and does <u>NOT</u> need to quarantine at home.

Even though your child is not a close contact and does not need to quarantine at home, please continue to check your child's health every day for fever and symptoms of respiratory illness.

#### Consider the following Georgia Department of Public Health (DPH) recommendations:

 BEFORE SENDING YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL or the SCHOOL BUS, check your child every day for COVID-19 symptoms:

Fever or chills	New severe/bad headache
New cough	New loss of taste or smell
Shortness of breath or	New congestion or runny nose

2. If your child develops COVID-19 symptoms, please keep them out of school and group activities,

such as sports or play groups, and contact your child's healthcare provider as soon as possible. Tell the healthcare provider that a COVID-19 case was identified in your child's school. DPH recommends your child get tested for COVID-19 if they develop symptoms, even if they are fully vaccinated.

 Call the school IMMEDIATELY, if your child develops COVID-19 symptoms <u>OR</u> has direct contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19.

 Talk to your child about COVID-19 and remind them to wear a mask if they are not vaccinated against COVID-19 (or even if they are fully vaccinated) and follow physical distancing guidance.
