Dr. Duncan share with the team that Junior Achievement Academy is coming to Douglass High School for the 2017-2018 school year. 150 students will part take in the new program. These students will engage with Chick Fil A and other businesses to learn business and marketing skills.



Dr. Neely has been very instrumental in getting these new programs set up for Douglass. Another program that she has successfully recruited for Douglass is Point University. Point University will

teach our students right on the Douglass High School campus. This initiative is open to all junior and seniors within Douglass.

The Stem Academy/ Early College will also be a new offering for students at Douglass. Student will be able to be on an accelerated pathway. Students in the 9th grade will take 10th grade courses, thus pushing them forward to advance yearly so by the time they reach their junior year they would have begun college course work. By 12th grade students will have credits towards sophomore college work. All of this course work will count as a part of students' college transcript.

The Stem programs is also focusing on becoming STEM Citified by 2019-2020 school term.

Dr. Duncan is also looking forward to Douglass High School gaining higher CCRPI scores in the upcoming years.
