a. Current Strategic Plan

I. Timeline: (Sept.- Dec. 2022) Utilizing current data, the GO TEAM will review and possibly update the school strategic priorities and plan

II. SMART Goals:

- Increase the percentage of grades 3-5 students scoring proficient or above in reading bby 3% from 25.62% to 28.62%
- Increase the percentage of grades 3-5 students scoring proficient or above in math by 3% from 21.67 to 24.67%.
- 70% of students (from the fall to the spring administration) will respond favorably to the BASC-3 Survey

III. School Priorities:

- Improve students' mastery of core content knowledge
- Cultivate a rigorous STEM program model (phase 2),
- Prepare all students to have the essential life skills to be self-aware, collaborative, and accepting of diversity
- Build systems identifying and addressing root causes to promote social and academic growth
- Build systems and resources to support STEM implementation
- Build teacher capacity in core content areas, particularly Math and ELA
- Inform and engage the school community

- **IV. Strategies** several strategies were developed last school year to achieve the school's priorities. In the coming months, the GO TEAM will further review these strategies to ensure that it is consistent with the current work being done at Hutchinson.

b. Continuous Improvement Plan

I. SMART Goals

- At the conclusion of the 2023 school year, the percentage of students in grades 3rd-5th scoring in the beginning category will decrease by 63% to 58% and the percentage of students scoring proficient or above will increase from 8% to 11% in Reading/ ELA based on milestone data.
- At the conclusion of the 2023 school year, the percentage of students in grades 3rd-5th scoring in the beginning category will decrease by 48% to 43% and the percentage of students scoring proficient or above will increase from 14% to 17% in math based on milestones data.
- At the conclusion of the 2023 school year, the percentage of students in grades Kindergarten through 5th grade meeting CCRPI Attendance Criteria will increase from 58.5% to 63.5% minimum based on State of Georgia CCRPI guidelines.
