In Mathematics, Hutchinson experienced a slight decrease in scores, falling in line with the district overall. 5<sup>th</sup> grade students were most deeply impacted. 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students demonstrated the highest achievement. Third grade students are receiving the most academic recovery and instructional preparation post-pandemic.
