a. **General School Updates:**

- PBIS implementation begin in August. PBIS- behavior norms and expectations have been adopted across Hutchinson. Teachers have been trained on PBIS expectations.
- Return of partners- Northwestern Mutual continues to support Hutchinson. Delta Airlines donated several school supplies and uniforms. In addition, Delta Book Buddies are scheduled to come in the month of October.

b. **School Priorities:**

- I. Fostering Academic Excellence for All- Improve students' mastery of core content knowledge, cultivate a rigorous STEM program model (phase 2), prepare all students to have the essential life skills to be self-aware, collaborative, and accepting of diversity

- II. Building a Culture of Student Support- Build systems identifying and addressing root causes to promote social and academic growth, build systems and resources to support STEM implementation
- III. Equipping and Empowering Leaders and Staff- build teacher capacity in core content areas, particularly Math and ELA
- IV. Creating a System of School Support- Inform and engage the school community, develop a positive school culture

Dark Green- distinguished/advanced; **Green-** proficient; **Yellow-** developing; **Red-** did not meet the standard

- Teachers have further dissected GMAS data into domains to inform their instruction.
- Hutchinson's School Improvement Plan (SIP) goal is to decrease students not meeting by 5% and increase the percentage of proficient students by 3-5%.
- 6% of our students with disabilities (SWD) met or exceeded standards in ELA and 12% met or exceeded standards in math.
- 4% of English Language Learners (ELL) scored proficiency or above in ELA and 12% in math.

College Career Readiness Performance Index (CCRPI)- Attendance is an area of growth. There has been some improvement from last school year.

Glow- areas of strengths

- Students are demonstrating consistent growth in mathematics
- ELL and SWD students are demonstrating proficiency in subject areas
- Hutchinson had 5th graders performing at proficient and distinguished in science.

Grows- areas for growth

- Phonemic awareness and the writing process are targeted areas of growth to enhance our ELA data
- Only 58% of Hutchinson students were present 90% of the time
