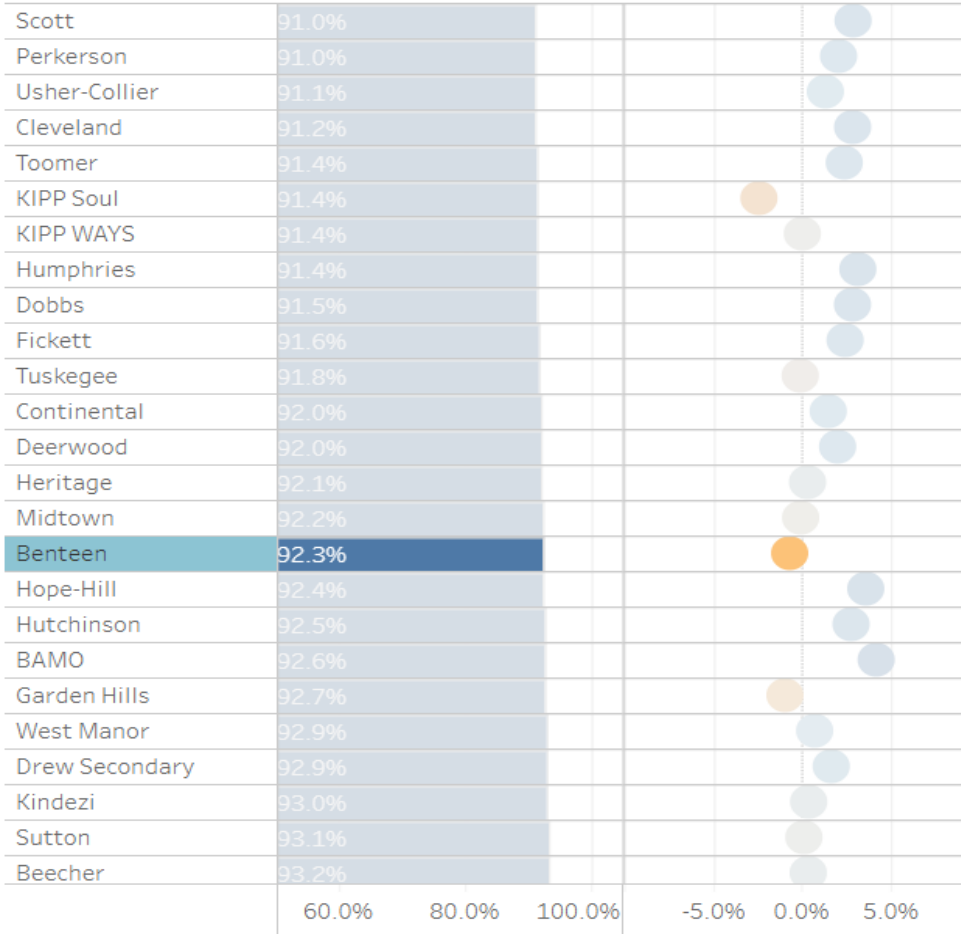

School ADA Attendance Comparison SY2022-2023



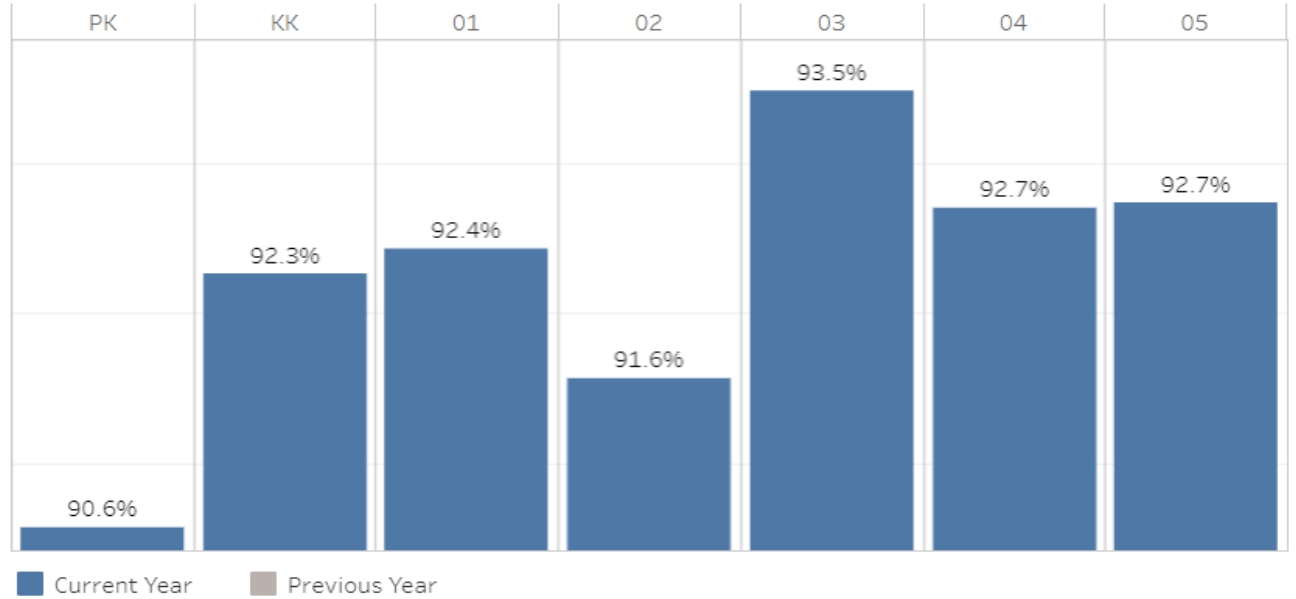

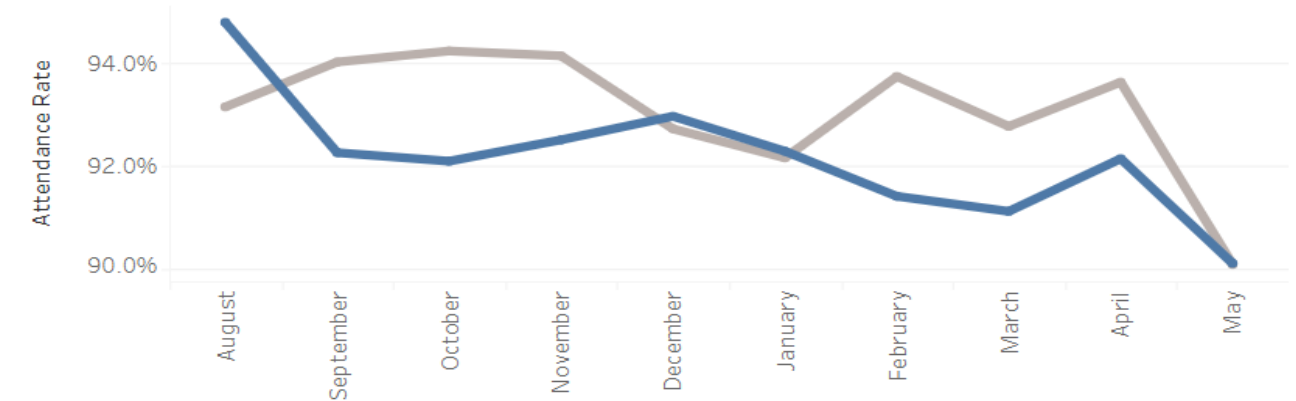
