- d. Ranking Strategic Plan Priorities in preparation for the FY 23-24 school budget
  - i. What doe this ranking mean as it informs our job in creating the budget? The rankings will determine where our resources are going to go.
  - ii. There is some overlap in certain areas and priorities (e.g.Fostering Academic Excellence for All and Quipping and Empowering Leaders and Staff).
  - iii. Discussion on ordering and on which priorities may need larger budget allocation versus priorities that can be done in house with fewer resources.
  - iv. Recruitment and retention may be a concern may be a concern as school status changes to Title I school.
  - v. PLC = Professional Learning Communities groups that teachers are involved in during the school day.
  - vi. How does the change in Title I standing impact the budget? Title I funding is imbedded in the budget that we receive which means a reduction in the overall budget. We may need to lean on SOFi a little more in order to support things we don't want to lose as a result of the Title I change.
  - vii. Haydee Romero votes to change language from "English Language Learner" to Multilingual Learner.





- viii. Ranking of Strategic Plan Priorities as appearing on the screen and after discussion:
  - 1. Increase student performance in ELA.
  - 2. Increase student performance in Math. (we will be getting resources from the district for next year)
  - 3. Retain and develop highly qualified teachers and staff in traditional, Dual Language Immersion, and support classes.
  - 4. Improve teacher efficacy in IB standards and practices, Balanced Literacy Framework, Eureka Math, and science/social studies integration.
  - 5. Embed a data-driven, multi-tiered system of support to improve our English Learner performance.
  - 6. Implement the enhanced IB PYP model with fidelity.
  - 7. Develop and sustain a positive, informed, and engaged school community for all stakeholders (students, teachers, parents, and the community)
  - 8. Create a culture of high expectations and trust for students, staff, and families.
  - 9. Develop a staffing model that provides opportunities for ongoing collaboration across grade levels and disciplines.
