IV. Discussion Items

- a. **Discussion Item 1**: Georgia Milestones student growth percentiles
 - i. Shavaun Mincey highlighted that Bolton Academy achieved growth in every content area across all grades. Additionally, Bolton stands at #3 in the North Atlanta cluster for math scores.
 - ii. Bolton demonstrates growth at an accelerated speed. In 2024, students scored 7% higher in math and 5% higher in ELA compared to 2023.
 - iii. Shavaun Mincey shared student growth percentiles and subgroup performance by race and ethnicity. Historically in Atlanta Public Schools, white and Asian students perform higher compared to other subgroups. The data for Bolton Academy presents those same gaps, but the gaps are not as wide as they are across other Atlanta public schools.

b. **Discussion Item 2**: Inclusivity initiatives at Bolton

- i. Shavaun Mincey shared that she recently received feedback from families that the winter and spring celebrations which take place at school lean more towards centering Christian holidays than other cultural holidays. This experience doesn't feel inclusive.
- ii. The group discussed ideas for embracing and celebrating the rich diversity at Bolton Academy, including two International Weeks (one in the winter and one in the spring). Each international week would provide an opportunity for students to research and write about an international country, culture, or tradition.
- iii. The curriculum would be a school-based approach, not a class-by-class experience.
